A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4465 AS INTRODUCED 3-8-05

House Bill 4465 would amend the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act to prohibit a person in Michigan from using the Internet to operate a firearm, bow, or crossbow for the purpose of taking an animal, whether or not the animal is in the state.
