A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4889 AS INTRODUCED 6-7-05

The bill would amend the Michigan Vehicle Code. Currently, the code prohibits the Department of Transportation from releasing information to a nongovernmental agency relating to an accident on the record of a police officer, fire fighter, or a person authorized to operate an ambulance or other emergency vehicle <u>if</u> the accident occurred while the person was operating the vehicle in the course of employment. <u>House Bill 4889</u> would add **a public highway authority employee** to the list.
