H.B. 5319 & 5320: FLOOR ANALYSIS

House Bills 5319 and 5320 (as reported without amendment) Sponsor: Representative Tonya Schuitmaker (H.B. 5319)

Representative Kevin Elsenheimer (H.B. 5320)

Senate Committee: Economic Development, Small Business and Regulatory Reform

CONTENT

House Bill 5319 would amend the Business Corporation Act to provide that a shareholder's abstention from a vote or submission of a ballot marked "abstain" with respect to an action would not be a vote cast on that action, unless otherwise provided in the articles of incorporation.

House Bill 5320 would amend the Business Corporation Act to provide that a shareholder's abstaining from a vote or submission of a ballot market "abstain" with respect to an action that required authorization by a vote of a class or series would not be a vote cast on that action, unless otherwise provided in the articles of incorporation.

The bills are tie-barred to each other.
