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House Bill 5927 (Substitute H-1 as discharged)

CONTENT

The bill would amend the Mental Health Code to require the Director of the Department of Community Health (DCH) to appoint a medical director of mental health services who was an appropriately credentialed psychiatrist. The medical director would have to do all of the following:

- Advise the DCH Director on mental health policy and treatment issues.
- Serve as a resource on mental health clinical matters to all divisions within the DCH, other State departments, and the mental health field.
- Promote the use of mental health care and treatment best practices that were scientifically validated and recovery-oriented.
