House Bills 6062, 6063, and 6064 (as reported without amendment)

CONTENT

House Bills 6062, 6063, and 6064 would amend the Public Health Code to reenact in Parts 165 (Acupuncture), 188 (Veterinary Medicine), and 187 (Respiratory Care), respectively, provisions that would be repealed by House Bill 6147, to which the bills are tie-barred.

House Bill 6147 would repeal Sections 16131 and 16263 of the Code, which prescribe the length and expiration date of terms of members serving on boards regulating various health occupations, and restrict the use of certain words, titles, and letters to individuals authorized to use them under the Code, respectively.
