HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4434

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 17753.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 17753. (1) A PHARMACY MAY PERFORM CENTRALIZED
- 2 PRESCRIPTION PROCESSING SERVICES OR OUTSOURCE THOSE SERVICES TO
- 3 ANOTHER PHARMACY IF EACH OF THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS IS SATISFIED:
- 4 (A) THE PHARMACIES HAVE THE SAME OWNER OR HAVE A WRITTEN
- 5 CONTRACT OUTLINING THE SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED AND THE
- 6 RESPONSIBILITIES AND ACCOUNTABILITIES OF EACH PHARMACY IN
- 7 FULFILLING THE TERMS OF THE CONTRACT IN COMPLIANCE WITH FEDERAL AND
- 8 STATE LAWS AND REGULATIONS.
- 9 (B) THE PHARMACIES SHARE A COMMON ELECTRONIC FILE OR HAVE
- 10 APPROPRIATE TECHNOLOGY TO ALLOW ACCESS TO SUFFICIENT INFORMATION

- 1 NECESSARY OR REQUIRED TO PREPARE A PRESCRIPTION DRUG ORDER.
- 2 (C) THE PHARMACIES COMPLY WITH FEDERAL AND STATE LAWS AND
- 3 REGULATIONS.
- 4 (2) A PHARMACY THAT PERFORMS, OR CONTRACTS FOR, CENTRALIZED
- 5 PRESCRIPTION PROCESSING SERVICES SHALL MAINTAIN A POLICY AND
- 6 PROCEDURES MANUAL, ALONG WITH DOCUMENTATION THAT IMPLEMENTATION IS
- 7 OCCURRING, AND EACH SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE BOARD FOR
- 8 INSPECTION AND REVIEW UPON REQUEST AND THE MANUAL SHALL INCLUDE,
- 9 BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, A DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF HOW THE PHARMACIES
- 10 WILL DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 11 (A) MAINTAIN APPROPRIATE RECORDS TO IDENTIFY THE RESPONSIBLE
- 12 PHARMACIST, OR PHARMACISTS, IN THE VARIOUS STAGES OF THE DRUG
- 13 PRODUCT PREPARATION, DISPENSING, AND COUNSELING PROCESS.
- 14 (B) TRACK THE PRESCRIPTION DRUG ORDER DURING EACH STEP IN THE
- 15 DRUG PRODUCT PREPARATION, DISPENSING, AND COUNSELING PROCESS.
- 16 (C) IDENTIFY ON THE PRESCRIPTION LABEL EACH PHARMACY INVOLVED
- 17 IN THE PREPARATION AND DISPENSING OF THE PRESCRIPTION DRUG ORDER.
- 18 (D) PROVIDE ADEQUATE SECURITY TO PROTECT THE CONFIDENTIALITY
- 19 AND INTEGRITY OF A PATIENT'S PROTECTED HEALTH INFORMATION.
- 20 (E) IMPLEMENT AND MAINTAIN A QUALITY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR
- 21 PHARMACY SERVICES DESIGNED TO OBJECTIVELY AND SYSTEMATICALLY
- 22 MONITOR AND EVALUATE THE QUALITY AND APPROPRIATENESS OF PATIENT
- 23 CARE, PURSUE OPPORTUNITIES TO IMPROVE PATIENT CARE, AND RESOLVE
- 24 IDENTIFIED PROBLEMS.
- 25 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "CENTRALIZED PRESCRIPTION
- 26 PROCESSING" MEANS THE PROCESSING BY A PHARMACY OF A REQUEST FROM
- 27 ANOTHER PHARMACY TO FILL OR REFILL A PRESCRIPTION DRUG ORDER OR TO

- PERFORM PROCESSING FUNCTIONS SUCH AS DISPENSING, PERFORMING DRUG 1
- 2 UTILIZATION REVIEW, COMPLETING CLAIMS ADJUDICATION, OBTAINING
- REFILL AUTHORIZATIONS, INITIATING THERAPEUTIC INTERVENTIONS, AND 3
- 4 OTHER FUNCTIONS RELATED TO THE PRACTICE OF PHARMACY.
- 5 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- unless Senate Bill No. 352 of the 93rd Legislature is enacted into 6
- 7 law.
