SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 162

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"

(MCL 436.1101 to 436.2303) by adding section 521a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 521A. (1) IN ORDER TO ALLOW CITIES TO ENHANCE THE QUALITY
- 2 OF LIFE FOR THEIR RESIDENTS AND VISITORS TO THEIR COMMUNITIES, THE
- 3 COMMISSION MAY ISSUE PUBLIC ON-PREMISES LICENSES IN ADDITION TO
- 4 THOSE QUOTA LICENSES ALLOWED IN CITIES UNDER SECTION 531(1). THE
- 5 LICENSES UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE ISSUED TO BUSINESSES THAT MEET
- 6 1 OF THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:
- 7 (A) ARE LOCATED IN A CITY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA MEETING
- 8 THE CRITERIA DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTIONS (3) AND (4) AND ARE ENGAGED
- 9 IN ACTIVITIES DETERMINED BY THE COMMISSION TO BE RELATED TO DINING,

- 1 ENTERTAINMENT, OR RECREATION.
- 2 (B) ARE LOCATED IN A DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT OR AREA THAT IS ANY
- 3 OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 4 (i) AN AUTHORITY DISTRICT ESTABLISHED UNDER THE TAX INCREMENT
- 5 FINANCE AUTHORITY ACT, 1980 PA 450, MCL 125.1801 TO 125.1830.
- 6 (ii) A DEVELOPMENT AREA ESTABLISHED UNDER THE CORRIDOR
- 7 IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY ACT, 2005 PA 280, MCL 125.2871 TO 125.2898.
- 8 (iii) A DOWNTOWN DISTRICT ESTABLISHED UNDER 1975 PA 197, MCL
- 9 125.1651 TO 125.1681.
- 10 (iv) A PRINCIPAL SHOPPING DISTRICT ESTABLISHED UNDER 1961 PA
- 11 120, MCL 125.981 TO 125.990M.
- 12 (2) THE COMMISSION SHALL NOT ISSUE A LICENSE UNDER SUBSECTION
- 13 (1) (A) UNLESS THE APPLICANT FULFILLS THE FOLLOWING IN RELATION TO
- 14 THE LICENSED PREMISES:
- 15 (A) PROVIDES THE ACTIVITY DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) (A) NOT
- 16 LESS THAN 5 DAYS PER WEEK.
- 17 (B) IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC NOT LESS THAN 10 HOURS PER DAY, 5
- 18 DAYS PER WEEK.
- 19 (C) PRESENTS VERIFICATION OF REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA STATUS
- 20 TO THE COMMISSION THAT SHALL INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:
- 21 (i) A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY ESTABLISHING
- 22 ITS STATUS AS A REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA.
- 23 (ii) AN AFFIDAVIT FROM THE ASSESSOR, AS CERTIFIED BY THE CITY
- 24 CLERK, STATING THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF INVESTMENT IN REAL AND PERSONAL
- 25 PROPERTY WITHIN THE REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA OF THE CITY DURING
- 26 THE PRECEDING 3 YEARS. IN THE CASE OF AN APPLICANT SEEKING A
- 27 LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION WITHIN THE FIRST LICENSE CYCLE AFTER THE

- 1 EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION, THE TIME PERIOD DESCRIBED IN THIS
- 2 SUBDIVISION MAY BE UP TO 5 YEARS<, OR 7 YEARS FOR A CITY HAVING A POPULATION BETWEEN 80,000 AND 85,000 ACCORDING TO THE 2000 FEDERAL DECENNIAL CENSUS AND THE APPLICATION IS SUBMITTED WITHIN THE FIRST 6 MONTHS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION>>.
- 3 (iii) AN AFFIDAVIT FROM THE ASSESSOR, AS CERTIFIED BY THE CITY
- 4 CLERK, SEPARATELY STATING THE AMOUNT OF INVESTMENT MONEY EXPENDED
- 5 FOR MANUFACTURING, INDUSTRIAL, RESIDENTIAL, AND COMMERCIAL
- 6 DEVELOPMENT WITHIN THE REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA OF THE CITY
- 7 DURING THE PRECEDING 3 YEARS. IN THE CASE OF AN APPLICANT SEEKING A
- 8 LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION WITHIN THE FIRST LICENSE CYCLE AFTER THE
- 9 EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION, THE TIME PERIOD DESCRIBED IN THIS
- 10 SUBDIVISION MAY BE UP TO 5 YEARS<, OR 7 YEARS FOR A CITY HAVING A POPULATION BETWEEN 80,000 AND 85,000 ACCORDING TO THE 2000 FEDERAL DECENNIAL CENSUS AND THE APPLICATION IS SUBMITTED WITHIN THE FIRST 6 MONTHS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION>>.
- 11 (3) RELATIVE TO THE LICENSES ISSUED UNDER SUBSECTION (1)(A),
- 12 THE AMOUNT OF COMMERCIAL INVESTMENT IN THE REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT
- 13 AREA WITHIN THE CITY SHALL CONSTITUTE NOT LESS THAN 25% OF THE
- 14 TOTAL INVESTMENT IN REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY IN THAT
- 15 REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA AS EVIDENCED BY AN AFFIDAVIT OF THE CITY
- 16 ASSESSOR. THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT PREVENT THE CITY FROM REALIGNING
- 17 THE REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA IN THE PRESENTMENT OF VERIFICATION
- 18 PROVIDED FOR UNDER SUBSECTION (2)(C).
- 19 (4) IN RELATION TO A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER SUBSECTION (1)(A),
- 20 AN APPLICANT SHALL BE LOCATED IN A CITY THAT MEETS AT LEAST 1 OF
- 21 THE INVESTMENT REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (1) (A) DURING THE 3 YEARS
- 22 PRECEDING THE SUBMISSION OF ITS APPLICATION, OR WITHIN THE
- 23 PRECEDING 5 YEARS IN THE CASE OF AN APPLICANT APPLYING DURING THE
- 24 FIRST LICENSE CYCLE AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION. THE
- 25 TOTAL INVESTMENT IN REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY IN THE REDEVELOPMENT
- 26 PROJECT AREA WITHIN THE CITY OVER THE APPROPRIATE TIME PERIOD
- 27 DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE AT LEAST 1 OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 1 (A) NOT LESS THAN \$50,000,000.00 IN CITIES HAVING A POPULATION
- 2 OF 50,000 OR MORE.
- 3 (B) NOT LESS THAN AN AMOUNT REFLECTING \$1,000,000.00 PER 1,000
- 4 PEOPLE IN CITIES HAVING A POPULATION OF LESS THAN 50,000.
- 5 (5) THE COMMISSION MAY ISSUE A LICENSE UNDER SUBSECTION (1)(A)
- 6 FOR EACH MONETARY THRESHOLD DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (4)(A) AND (B),
- 7 AND, AFTER REACHING THE INITIAL THRESHOLD, 1 ADDITIONAL LICENSE FOR
- 8 EACH MAJOR FRACTION THEREOF ABOVE THAT ORIGINAL THRESHOLD.
- 9 (6) THE FOLLOWING APPLY TO A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER SUBSECTION
- 10 (1)(B):
- 11 (A) THE AMOUNT EXPENDED FOR THE REHABILITATION OR RESTORATION
- 12 OF THE BUILDING THAT HOUSED THE LICENSED PREMISES SHALL BE NOT LESS
- 13 THAN \$75,000.00 OVER A PERIOD OF THE PRECEDING 5 YEARS OR A
- 14 COMMITMENT FOR A CAPITAL INVESTMENT OF AT LEAST THAT AMOUNT IN THE
- 15 BUILDING THAT HOUSES THE LICENSED PREMISES, WHICH MUST BE EXPENDED
- 16 BEFORE THE ISSUANCE OF THE LICENSE.
- 17 (B) THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE INVESTMENT IN REAL
- 18 AND PERSONAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE QUALIFIED REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT
- 19 AREA SHALL NOT BE LESS THAN \$200,000.00 OVER A PERIOD OF THE
- 20 PRECEDING 5 YEARS AS VERIFIED TO THE COMMISSION BY MEANS OF AN
- 21 AFFIDAVIT FROM THE ASSESSOR, AS CERTIFIED BY THE CLERK OF THE LOCAL
- 22 GOVERNMENTAL UNIT.
- (C) THE LICENSED BUSINESS IS ENGAGED IN DINING, ENTERTAINMENT,
- 24 OR RECREATION, IS OPEN TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC, AND HAS A SEATING
- 25 CAPACITY OF NOT LESS THAN 50 PERSONS.
- 26 (7) THE COMMISSION MAY ISSUE 1 LICENSE FOR EACH MONETARY
- 27 THRESHOLD DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (6)(B), OR FOR EACH MAJOR

- 1 FRACTION THEREOF. THE [INITIAL ENHANCED] LICENSE FEE FOR A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS
- 2 SECTION IS \$20,000.00.
- 3 (8) THE COMMISSION SHALL NOT TRANSFER A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER
- 4 THIS SECTION TO ANOTHER LOCATION. IF THE LICENSEE GOES OUT OF
- 5 BUSINESS, THE LICENSEE SHALL SURRENDER THE LICENSE TO THE
- 6 COMMISSION. THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL UNIT MAY
- 7 APPROVE ANOTHER APPLICANT WITHIN A CITY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA
- 8 TO REPLACE A LICENSEE WHO HAS SURRENDERED THE LICENSE ISSUED UNDER
- 9 THIS SECTION PROVIDED THE NEW APPLICANT'S BUSINESS MEETS THE
- 10 REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION BUT WITHOUT REGARD TO SUBSECTIONS
- 11 (2)(C), (3), AND (4) OR SUBSECTION (6)(B).
- 12 (9) THE INDIVIDUAL SIGNING THE APPLICATION FOR THE LICENSE
- 13 SHALL STATE AND DEMONSTRATE THAT THE APPLICANT ATTEMPTED TO SECURE
- 14 AN APPROPRIATE ON-PREMISE ESCROWED LICENSE OR QUOTA LICENSE ISSUED
- 15 UNDER SECTION 531 AND THAT, TO THE BEST OF HIS OR HER KNOWLEDGE, AN
- 16 ON-PREMISE LICENSE OR QUOTA LICENSE ISSUED UNDER SECTION 531 IS NOT
- 17 READILY AVAILABLE WITHIN THE LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT IN WHICH THE
- 18 APPLICANT PROPOSES TO OPERATE.
- 19 (10) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 20 (A) "CITY" MEANS A CITY ESTABLISHED UNDER EITHER OF THE
- 21 FOLLOWING:
- 22 (i) THE HOME RULE CITY ACT, 1909 PA 279, MCL 117.1 TO 117.38.
- 23 (ii) THE FOURTH CLASS CITY ACT, 1895 PA 215, MCL 81.1 TO
- 24 113.20.
- 25 (B) "ESCROWED LICENSE" MEANS A LICENSE IN WHICH THE RIGHTS OF
- 26 THE LICENSEE IN THE LICENSE OR TO THE RENEWAL OF THE LICENSE ARE
- 27 STILL IN EXISTENCE AND ARE SUBJECT TO RENEWAL AND ACTIVATION IN THE

- 1 MANNER PROVIDED FOR IN R 436.1107 OF THE MICHIGAN ADMINISTRATIVE
- 2 CODE.
- 3 (C) "READILY AVAILABLE" MEANS AVAILABLE UNDER A STANDARD OF
- 4 ECONOMIC FEASIBILITY, AS APPLIED TO THE SPECIFIC CIRCUMSTANCES OF
- 5 THE APPLICANT, THAT INCLUDES BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING:
- 6 (i) THE FAIR MARKET VALUE OF THE LICENSE, IF DETERMINABLE.
- 7 (ii) THE SIZE AND SCOPE OF THE PROPOSED OPERATION.
- 8 (iii) THE EXISTENCE OF MANDATORY CONTRACTUAL RESTRICTIONS OR
- 9 INCLUSIONS ATTACHED TO THE SALE OF THE LICENSE.
- 10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 11 unless Senate Bill No. 163 of the 93rd Legislature is enacted into
