

HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR  
SENATE BILL NO. 373

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled  
"The Michigan penal code,"  
(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 236b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1        SEC. 236B. (1) A PERSON IN THIS STATE SHALL NOT DO ANY OF THE  
2 FOLLOWING:

3        (A) ENGAGE IN COMPUTER-ASSISTED SHOOTING.

4        (B) PROVIDE OR OPERATE, WITH OR WITHOUT REMUNERATION,  
5 FACILITIES FOR COMPUTER-ASSISTED SHOOTING.

6        (C) PROVIDE OR OFFER TO PROVIDE, WITH OR WITHOUT REMUNERATION,  
7 EQUIPMENT SPECIALLY ADAPTED FOR COMPUTER-ASSISTED SHOOTING. THIS  
8 SUBDIVISION DOES NOT PROHIBIT PROVIDING OR OFFERING TO PROVIDE ANY  
9 OF THE FOLLOWING:

1           (i) GENERAL-PURPOSE EQUIPMENT, INCLUDING A COMPUTER, A CAMERA,  
2 FENCING, BUILDING MATERIALS, OR A BOW OR CROSSBOW.

3           (ii) GENERAL-PURPOSE COMPUTER SOFTWARE, INCLUDING AN OPERATING  
4 SYSTEM AND COMMUNICATIONS PROGRAMS.

5           (iii) GENERAL TELECOMMUNICATIONS HARDWARE OR NETWORKING SERVICES  
6 FOR COMPUTERS, INCLUDING ADAPTERS, MODEMS, SERVERS, ROUTERS, AND  
7 OTHER FACILITIES ASSOCIATED WITH INTERNET ACCESS.

8           (D) PROVIDE OR OFFER TO PROVIDE, WITH OR WITHOUT REMUNERATION,  
9 AN ANIMAL FOR COMPUTER-ASSISTED SHOOTING.

10          (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:

11          (A) "COMPUTER-ASSISTED SHOOTING" MEANS THE USE OF A COMPUTER  
12 OR ANY OTHER DEVICE, EQUIPMENT, OR SOFTWARE TO REMOTELY CONTROL THE  
13 AIMING AND DISCHARGE OF A BOW OR CROSSBOW TO KILL AN ANIMAL,  
14 WHETHER OR NOT THE ANIMAL IS LOCATED IN THIS STATE.

15          (B) "FACILITIES FOR COMPUTER-ASSISTED REMOTE SHOOTING"  
16 INCLUDES REAL PROPERTY AND IMPROVEMENTS ON THE PROPERTY ASSOCIATED  
17 WITH COMPUTER-ASSISTED SHOOTING, SUCH AS HUNTING BLINDS, OFFICES,  
18 AND ROOMS EQUIPPED TO FACILITATE COMPUTER-ASSISTED SHOOTING.

19          Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect  
20 unless all of the following bills of the 93rd Legislature are  
21 enacted into law:
