SENATE BILL NO. 548

A bill to amend 1972 PA 222, entitled

"An act to provide for an official personal identification card; to provide for its form, issuance and use; to regulate the use and disclosure of information obtained from the card; to prescribe the powers and duties of the secretary of state; to prescribe fees; to prescribe certain penalties for violations; and to provide an appropriation for certain purposes,"

by amending section 7 (MCL 28.297), as added by 1997 PA 99.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- **1** Sec. 7. (1) The secretary of state may provide a commercial
- 2 look-up service of records maintained under this act. For each
- 3 individual record looked up, the secretary of state shall charge a
- 4 fee specified annually by the legislature, or if the legislature
- 5 does not specify a fee, a market-based price established by the
- 6 secretary of state. The secretary of state shall process a
- 7 commercial look-up request only if the request is in a form or

- 7 (2) The secretary of state shall establish and maintain a
- 8 computerized central file of the information contained on

- 12 1974 PA 163, MCL 28.211 to 28.216.
- 13 (3) Except as provided in section 10(2), the secretary of
- 14 state shall not provide an entire computerized central file or
- 15 other file of records maintained under this act to a
- 16 nongovernmental person or entity, unless the purchaser pays the

- 18 computerized file.
