THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 43502. (1) "ACCOMPANY" MEANS TO GO ALONG WITH ANOTHER
- 2 PERSON UNDER CIRCUMSTANCES THAT ALLOW ONE TO COME TO THE IMMEDIATE
- 3 AID OF THE OTHER PERSON AND WHILE STAYING WITHIN A DISTANCE FROM
- 4 THE PERSON THAT PERMITS UNINTERRUPTED, UNAIDED VISUAL AND AUDITORY
- 5 COMMUNICATION.
- 6 (2) -(1) "Amphibian" means -any A frog, toad, salamander, or
- 7 any other member of the class amphibia.

- 1 (3) "APPRENTICE LICENSE" MEANS A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER SECTION
- 2 43520(3).
- 3 (4) -(2) "Aquatic species" means -any A fish, reptile,
- 4 amphibian, mollusk, aquatic insect, or crustacea or part thereof.
- 5 (5) -(3) "Bow" means a device for propelling an arrow from a
- 6 string drawn, held, and released by hand where IF the force used
- 7 to hold the string in the drawn position is provided by the
- 8 archer's muscles.
- 9 (6) -(4) "Crossbow" means a weapon consisting of a bow, WITH
- 10 A DRAW WEIGHT OF 100 POUNDS OR MORE, mounted transversely on a
- 11 stock or frame and designed to fire an arrow, bolt, or quarrel by
- 12 the release of a bow string -that is controlled by a mechanical or
- 13 electric trigger and has WITH a working safety. and a draw
- 14 weight of 100 pounds or more.
- 15 (7) (5)— "Crustacea" means any— A freshwater crayfish,
- 16 shrimp, or prawn of the order decapoda.
- 17 Sec. 43505. (1) "Hunt" and "hunting" mean to pursue, capture,
- 18 shoot, kill, chase, follow, harass, harm, rob, or trap a wild
- 19 animal, or to attempt to engage in such an activity.
- 20 (2) "Identification" means a driver license issued by
- 21 Michigan, another state, or a Canadian province as accepted by the
- 22 department, a state of Michigan identification card issued by the
- 23 secretary of state, or a sportcard issued by the department.
- 24 (3) "License" means a document or a tag, stamp, plastic card,
- 25 or other device that may include a stamp or a tag that authorizes
- 26 the licensee to hunt, fish, trap, or possess wild animals or
- 27 aquatic species and other identification required by the

- 2 (4) "Minor child" means a person less than 17 years of age
- 3 OLD.
- 4 (5) "Nonresident" means OR REFERS TO a person who is not a
- 5 resident. who is 17 years of age or older.
- 6 Sec. 43506. (1) "Open season" means the time during which game
- 7 animals, game birds, fur-bearing animals, and aquatic species may
- 8 be legally taken or killed. Open season includes both the first and
- 9 last day of the season or period.
- 10 (2) "Reptile" means a turtle, snake, lizard, or any other
- 11 member of the class reptilia.
- 12 (3) "Resident" means OR REFERS TO any of the following:
- 13 (a) A person who resides in a settled or permanent home or
- 14 domicile within the boundaries of this state with the intention of
- 15 remaining in this state.
- 16 (b) A student who is enrolled in a full-time course at a
- 17 college or university within this state and who resides in the
- 18 state during the school year.
- 19 (c) A person regularly enlisted or commissioned as an officer
- 20 in the armed forces of the United States and officially stationed
- 21 in this state.
- 22 (d) A person regularly enlisted or commissioned as an officer
- 23 in the armed forces of the United States who, at the time of
- 24 enlistment, was a resident of this state and has maintained his or
- 25 her residence in this state for purposes of obtaining a driver
- 26 license or voter registration, or both.
- 27 Sec. 43517. A parent or legal guardian of a minor child shall

- 1 not permit or allow the minor child to hunt GAME under the
- 2 authority of a license issued pursuant to this part EXCEPT UNDER 1
- 3 OF THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:
- 4 (A) THE MINOR CHILD HUNTS ONLY on land upon which -the- A
- 5 parent or guardian is -not- regularly domiciled -without being
- 6 accompanied by the OR A parent or guardian, or another person AT
- 7 LEAST 18 YEARS OLD authorized by the A parent or quardian, who
- 8 is 17 years of age or older ACCOMPANIES THE MINOR CHILD. THIS
- 9 SUBDIVISION DOES NOT APPLY UNDER EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING
- 10 CIRCUMSTANCES:
- 11 (i) THE LICENSE IS AN APPRENTICE LICENSE.
- 12 (ii) THE MINOR CHILD IS LESS THAN 14 YEARS OLD AND THE LICENSE
- 13 IS A LICENSE TO HUNT DEER, BEAR, OR ELK WITH A FIREARM.
- 14 (B) IF THE LICENSE IS AN APPRENTICE LICENSE, A PARENT OR
- 15 GUARDIAN, OR ANOTHER PERSON AT LEAST 21 YEARS OLD AUTHORIZED BY A
- 16 PARENT OR GUARDIAN, WHO IS LICENSED TO HUNT THAT GAME UNDER A
- 17 LICENSE OTHER THAN AN APPRENTICE LICENSE ACCOMPANIES THE MINOR
- 18 CHILD. IN ADDITION, IF THE MINOR CHILD IS LESS THAN 14 YEARS OLD
- 19 AND THE APPRENTICE LICENSE IS A LICENSE TO HUNT DEER, BEAR, OR ELK
- 20 WITH A FIREARM, THE MINOR CHILD SHALL HUNT ONLY ON PRIVATE
- 21 PROPERTY.
- 22 (C) IF THE MINOR CHILD IS LESS THAN 14 YEARS OLD AND THE
- 23 LICENSE IS A LICENSE TO HUNT DEER, BEAR, OR ELK WITH A FIREARM, THE
- 24 MINOR CHILD HUNTS ONLY ON PRIVATE PROPERTY AND A PARENT OR
- 25 GUARDIAN, OR ANOTHER PERSON AUTHORIZED BY A PARENT OR GUARDIAN WHO
- 26 IS AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD, ACCOMPANIES THE MINOR CHILD. THIS
- 27 SUBDIVISION DOES NOT APPLY IF THE LICENSE IS AN APPRENTICE LICENSE.

- 1 Sec. 43520. (1) Subject to other requirements of this part,
- 2 the department may issue a hunting license to a minor child
- 3 subject to both of the following conditions:
- 4 (a) On application of a IF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS
- 5 ARE MET:
- 6 (A) A parent or legal guardian of the minor child -, if the
- 7 minor child, when hunting on lands upon which the minor child's
- 8 parents are not regularly domiciled, is accompanied by the parent
- 9 or guardian or another person authorized by the parent or guardian
- 10 who is 17 years of age or older.
- 11 (b) Payment of the license fee.
- 12 (2) A APPLIES FOR THE LICENSE ON BEHALF OF THE MINOR CHILD.
- 13 (B) THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN REPRESENTS THAT THE REQUIREMENTS OF
- 14 SECTION 43517(A), (B), OR (C), AS APPLICABLE, WILL BE COMPLIED
- 15 WITH.
- 16 (C) THE MINOR CHILD IS AT LEAST 10 YEARS OLD OR, IF THE
- 17 LICENSE IS A license to hunt deer, bear, or elk with a firearm,
- 18 shall not be issued to a person who is less than 14 years of age
- 19 AT LEAST 12 YEARS OLD.
- 20 (3) A license to hunt shall not be issued to a person who is
- 21 less than 12 years of age.
- 22 (D) THE LICENSE FEE IS PAID.
- 23 (2) -(4)— A person authorized to sell hunting licenses shall
- 24 not issue a hunting license to a person born after January 1, 1960,
- 25 unless the person presents proof of previous hunting experience in
- 26 the form of a hunting license issued by this state, another state,
- 27 a province of Canada, or another country or PRESENTS a

- 1 certification of completion of training in hunter safety issued to
- 2 the person by this state, another state, a province of Canada, or
- 3 another country. If an applicant for a hunting license does not
- 4 have proof of SUCH a previous license or a certification of
- 5 completion of training in hunter safety, a person authorized to
- 6 sell hunting licenses may issue a hunting license if the applicant
- 7 submits a signed affidavit stating that -they have THE APPLICANT
- 8 HAS completed a course in hunter safety or that -they have THE
- 9 APPLICANT possessed SUCH a hunting license previously. The person
- 10 selling a hunting license shall record as specified by the
- 11 department the form of proof of the previous hunting experience or
- 12 certification of completion of hunter safety training presented by
- 13 the applicant. THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO THE ISSUANCE OF AN
- 14 APPRENTICE LICENSE. AN APPRENTICE LICENSE OR THE EQUIVALENT DOES
- 15 NOT SATISFY THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBSECTION CONCERNING PROOF OF
- 16 PREVIOUS HUNTING EXPERIENCE.
- 17 (3) A PERSON WHO DOES NOT MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION
- 18 (2) MAY OBTAIN AN APPRENTICE LICENSE FOR THE SAME PRICE AS THE
- 19 CORRESPONDING REGULAR LICENSE THAT THE PERSON WOULD OTHERWISE BE
- 20 QUALIFIED TO OBTAIN. A PERSON 17 YEARS OLD OR OLDER SHALL NOT HUNT
- 21 GAME UNDER AN APPRENTICE LICENSE UNLESS ANOTHER PERSON AT LEAST 21
- 22 YEARS OLD WHO POSSESSES A LICENSE, OTHER THAN AN APPRENTICE
- 23 LICENSE, TO HUNT THAT GAME ACCOMPANIES THAT APPRENTICE LICENSEE AND
- 24 DOES NOT ACCOMPANY MORE THAN 1 OTHER APPRENTICE LICENSEE. FOR THE
- 25 PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION AND SECTION 43517(B), A PERSON SHALL
- 26 NOT GO ALONG WITH MORE THAN 2 APPRENTICE LICENSEES OF ANY AGE FOR
- 27 THE PURPOSE OF ACCOMPANYING THOSE APPRENTICE LICENSEES WHILE THOSE

- APPRENTICE LICENSEES ARE HUNTING. IF A PERSON HAS REPRESENTED TO AN 1
- 2 APPRENTICE LICENSEE OR, IF THE APPRENTICE LICENSEE IS A MINOR
- CHILD, TO THE APPRENTICE LICENSEE'S PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN THAT 3
- 4 THE PERSON WOULD ACCOMPANY THE APPRENTICE LICENSEE FOR THE PURPOSES
- 5 OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE PERSON SHALL NOT GO ALONG WITH THE
- APPRENTICE LICENSEE WHILE THE APPRENTICE LICENSEE IS HUNTING UNLESS 6
- THE PERSON ACTUALLY ACCOMPANIES THE APPRENTICE LICENSEE AND 7
- POSSESSES A LICENSE, OTHER THAN AN APPRENTICE LICENSE, TO HUNT THE 8
- 9 SAME GAME AS THE APPRENTICE LICENSEE. A PERSON IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO
- 10 OBTAIN A SPECIFIC TYPE OF APPRENTICE LICENSE, SUCH AS A FIREARM
- DEER LICENSE, AN ARCHERY DEER LICENSE, A COMBINATION DEER LICENSE, 11
- 12 A SMALL GAME LICENSE, OR A TURKEY LICENSE, FOR MORE THAN 2 LICENSE
- YEARS. AN APPRENTICE LICENSE SHALL BE DISTINGUISHED FROM A LICENSE 13
- OTHER THAN AN APPRENTICE LICENSE BY A NOTATION OR OTHER MEANS. 14
- 15 (4) BY OCTOBER 1, 2008, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SUBMIT TO THE
- STANDING COMMITTEES OF THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES WITH 16
- 17 PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITY FOR CONSERVATION AND OUTDOOR RECREATION
- 18 ISSUES A REPORT ON THE EFFECT OF THE APPRENTICE HUNTER PROGRAM AND
- 19 THE REDUCTIONS IN MINIMUM HUNTING AGE ENACTED BY THE 2006
- 20 AMENDATORY ACT THAT AMENDED THIS SECTION ON RECRUITMENT OF NEW
- HUNTERS AND OTHER RELEVANT ISSUES, SUCH AS HUNTER SAFETY. 21
