SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 1199

(As amended May 11, 2006)

A bill to allow the requiring of a permit before demonstrating outside of locations in which a funeral service is being held; to allow local units of government to prohibit certain conduct at or near the locations in which a funeral service is being held; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain local governments and officials; and to provide for penalties.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. A local unit of government may pass such ordinances as
- 2 it considers necessary to protect and preserve the peace and
- 3 respect toward those attending or conducting a funeral or memorial
- 4 service.
- 5 Sec. 2. (1) An ordinance authorized under section 1 may
- 6 include the requiring of a permit before a person can demonstrate
- 7 on public property outside of any funeral home, church, [synagogue, mosque, any other place of worship,] cemetery,

- 1 or any other location at which a funeral service or memorial
- 2 service is being held.
- 3 (2) The local unit of government may assess a reasonable fee
- 4 for the processing and granting of a permit allowed under this act.
- 5 Sec. 3. The ordinance authorized under section 1 may also
- 6 include such other provisions as the local unit of government
- 7 considers necessary, including, but not limited to, prohibiting any
- 8 person from doing any of the following within 500 feet of a
- 9 building or other location where a funeral, memorial service, or
- 10 viewing of a deceased person is being conducted or within 500 feet
- 11 of a funeral procession or burial in the hour immediately before,
- 12 or during, or in the 2 hours immediately following:
- 13 (a) Making loud and raucous noise and continuing to do so
- 14 after being asked to stop.
- 15 (b) Making any statement or gesture that would make a
- 16 reasonable person under the circumstances feel intimidated,
- 17 threatened, or harassed.
- (c) Engaging in any other conduct that the person knows or
- 19 should reasonably know will disturb, disrupt, or adversely affect
- 20 the funeral, memorial service, viewing of the deceased person,
- 21 funeral procession, or burial.
- 22 Sec. 4. The local unit of government shall impose reasonable
- 23 fines for violations of an ordinance adopted under this act.
- Sec. 5. As used in this act, "local unit of government" means
- 25 a city, village, township, or county.
