SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4071

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled
"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"

(MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by amending the title, as amended by
1996 PA 434, and by adding section 43540a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 TITLE

- 2 An act to protect the environment and natural resources of the
- 3 state; to codify, revise, consolidate, and classify laws relating
- 4 to the environment and natural resources of the state; to regulate
- 5 the discharge of certain substances into the environment; to
- 6 regulate the use of certain lands, waters, and other natural
- 7 resources of the state; to prescribe the powers and duties of
- 8 certain state and local agencies and officials; to provide for
- 9 certain charges, fees, -and assessments, AND DONATIONS; to provide
- 10 certain appropriations; to prescribe penalties and provide

- 1 remedies; -to repeal certain parts of this act on a specific date;
- 2 and to repeal -certain acts and parts of acts.
- 3 SEC. 43540A. (1) BY JANUARY 1, 2007, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
- 4 IMPLEMENT A PROGRAM TO DISTRIBUTE WILD GAME TO PEOPLE IN NEED. THE
- 5 PROGRAM SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE SPORTSMEN AGAINST HUNGER PROGRAM.
- 6 (2) UNDER THE PROGRAM, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DO ALL OF THE
- 7 FOLLOWING:
- 8 (A) COLLECT DONATIONS OF LEGALLY TAKEN GAME THAT COMPLIES WITH
- 9 ALL STATE AND FEDERAL GAME LAWS, INCLUDING ANY REQUIREMENT THAT THE
- 10 PARTS OF THE GAME BE INTACT.
- 11 (B) CONTRACT FOR PROCESSING THE DONATED GAME.
- 12 (C) DISTRIBUTE THE PROCESSED GAME TO FOOD BANKS, SOUP
- 13 KITCHENS, AND OTHER CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS THAT PROVIDE MEALS OR
- 14 FOOD TO PEOPLE FREE OF CHARGE.
- 15 (D) PROMOTE THE PROGRAM THROUGH THE LICENSE DISTRIBUTION
- 16 SYSTEM AND OTHER MEANS THAT WILL FURTHER THE MISSION OF THE
- 17 PROGRAM.
- 18 (3) UNDER THE PROGRAM, THE DEPARTMENT MAY REQUEST FINANCIAL
- 19 DONATIONS TO OFFSET THE COST OF PROCESSING DONATED GAME. THE
- 20 FINANCIAL DONATIONS ARE TAX DEDUCTIBLE.
- 21 (4) THE DEPARTMENT MAY CONTRACT FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE
- 22 PROGRAM BY A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION THAT IS EXEMPT FROM TAXATION
- 23 UNDER SECTION 501(C)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE, 26 USC 501,
- 24 IF THE DEPARTMENT DETERMINES THAT IT IS MORE EFFICIENT TO DO SO.
- 25 SUBJECT TO THIS SUBSECTION, PAYMENTS UNDER THE CONTRACT SHALL BE
- 26 ADEQUATE TO COVER THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION'S COSTS IN
- 27 ADMINISTERING THE PROGRAM. HOWEVER, PAYMENTS SHALL NOT EXCEED THE

- 1 AMOUNT OF REVENUE AVAILABLE FOR SUCH PAYMENTS IN THE SPORTSMEN
- 2 AGAINST HUNGER FUND CREATED UNDER SECTION 43540C.
- 3 (5) TO QUALIFY TO ENTER A CONTRACT UNDER SUBSECTION (4), A
- 4 NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION MUST HAVE DEMONSTRATED A COMMITMENT TO THE
- 5 GOALS OF THE PROGRAM AND HAVE AT LEAST 5 YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN
- 6 PROVIDING WILD GAME OR OTHER FOOD TO PEOPLE FREE OF CHARGE. THE
- 7 CONTRACT SHALL REQUIRE THAT THE CONTRACTING NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION
- DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING: 8
- 9 (A) MAINTAIN A LICENSE UNDER THE CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS AND
- 10 SOLICITATIONS ACT, 1975 PA 169, MCL 400.271 TO 400.294.
- 11 (B) MAINTAIN ADEQUATE STAFF TO PERFORM THE TASKS OUTLINED IN
- 12 THE CONTRACT.
- 13 (C) ANNUALLY UNDERGO AN INDEPENDENT FINANCIAL AUDIT AND
- 14 PROVIDE THE AUDIT INFORMATION AND REPORT TO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 15 (i) THE DEPARTMENT.
- (ii) THE SUBCOMMITTEE OF THE SENATE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE 16
- AND THE SUBCOMMITTEE OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES APPROPRIATIONS 17
- 18 COMMITTEE WITH RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE BUDGET OF THE DEPARTMENT.
- 19 (iii) THE COMMITTEES OF THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
- 20 WITH PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITY FOR NATURAL RESOURCES ISSUES.
- 21 (6) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "PROGRAM" MEANS THE SPORTSMEN
- 22 AGAINST HUNGER PROGRAM CREATED UNDER SUBSECTION (1).
- 23 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 24 unless House Bill No. 4145 of the 93rd Legislature is enacted into
- 25 law.
