

HOUSE BILL No. 4118

(As amended April 28, 2005)

February 1, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Acciavatti, Sheltroun, Palmer, Robertson, Pavlov, Gosselin, LaJoy, Nitz, Gaffney and Walker and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled

"The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1318.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1318. (1) THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR BOARD OF
2 DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL ENSURE THAT ITS POLICIES
3 CONCERNING A PUPIL'S ELIGIBILITY FOR PARTICIPATION IN
4 INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS INCLUDE USE OF A PERFORMANCE-ENHANCING
5 SUBSTANCE BY THE PUPIL AS A VIOLATION THAT WILL AFFECT A PUPIL'S
6 ELIGIBILITY, AS DETERMINED BY THE BOARD OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS. [THE
7 GOVERNING BODY OF A NONPUBLIC SCHOOL IS ENCOURAGED TO ADOPT AN
8 ELIGIBILITY POLICY THAT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.]
- 7 (2) FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT OF
8 COMMUNITY HEALTH SHALL DEVELOP, PERIODICALLY UPDATE, AND MAKE

1 AVAILABLE TO SCHOOL DISTRICTS, PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMIES, AND
2 NONPUBLIC SCHOOLS A LIST OF PERFORMANCE-ENHANCING SUBSTANCES. THE
3 DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH SHALL BASE THE LIST ON THE LIST OF
4 BANNED DRUGS CONTAINED IN BYLAW 31.2.3.1 OF THE BYLAWS OF THE
5 NATIONAL COLLEGIATE ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION.
