SUBSTITUTE FOR

HOUSE BILL NO. 4315

A bill to amend 1909 PA 283, entitled

"An act to revise, consolidate, and add to the laws relating to the establishment, opening, discontinuing, vacating, closing, altering, improvement, maintenance, and use of the public highways and private roads; the condemnation of property and gravel therefor; the building, repairing and preservation of bridges; maintaining public access to waterways under certain conditions; setting and protecting shade trees, drainage, and cutting weeds and brush within this state; providing for the election or appointment and defining the powers, duties, and compensation of state, county, township, and district highway officials; and to prescribe penalties and provide remedies,"

by amending section 6 of chapter IV (MCL 224.6), as amended by 1982 PA 299.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 CHAPTER IV
- 2 Sec. 6. (1) In any EXCEPT AS PROVIDED UNDER THIS SECTION, IN
- 3 A county where the county road system is adopted, a board of county

- 1 road commissioners consisting of NOT LESS THAN 3 members OR MORE
- 2 THAN 5 MEMBERS shall be elected by the people of the county. -
- 3 except as provided in subsection (2). In the first instance, the
- 4 THE INITIAL ROAD commissioners shall be appointed by the county
- 5 board of commissioners or elected at a general or special election
- 6 called for that purpose, as shall be ordered **DETERMINED** by the
- 7 county board of -commissoners COMMISSIONERS. THE COUNTY BOARD OF
- 8 COMMISSIONERS MAY BY RESOLUTION PROVIDE FOR STAGGERED TERMS OF
- 9 OFFICE FOR THE ROAD COMMISSIONERS UNDER THIS SUBSECTION OR
- 10 SUBSECTION (6) SO THAT NOT MORE THAN 2 ROAD COMMISSIONERS' TERMS OF
- 11 OFFICE EXPIRE IN THE SAME YEAR.
- 12 (2) If the road commissioners are appointed, they shall hold
- 13 office only until January 1 of the first odd numbered year
- 14 following the date of appointment. If the road commissioners are to
- 15 be elected at a general OR SPECIAL election, notice of the
- 16 election, embodying a copy of the resolutions of the county board
- 17 of commissioners, giving the number and terms of the office of the
- 18 road commissioners to be elected, shall be published by the clerk
- 19 in the newspaper or newspapers selected by the county board of
- 20 commissioners as required by section 3 of this chapter. If a
- 21 special election is called for the election of the road
- 22 commissioners, an identical notice shall be given by the clerk,
- 23 which notice shall be posted and published in those newspapers as
- 24 required by section 3 of this chapter.
- 25 (3) The regular election of county road commissioners shall be
- 26 held at the general election on the first Tuesday after the first
- 27 Monday in November. The term of office of an elected county road

- 1 commissioner shall commence on January 1 in the year following his
- 2 or her election. The notice of the election shall be given at the
- 3 time notice is given of the general election of county officers.

- 5 (4) THE election of county road commissioners shall not be
- 6 mandatory in any county -which THAT contains ALL OR PART OF 12
- 7 surveyed townships or more, either entire or fractional as
- 8 determined by the government survey of the county. In such county
- 9 or counties EXCEPT AS PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (5), IN A COUNTY
- 10 UNDER THIS SUBSECTION the county board of commissioners, -may, by
- 11 a majority of its members elect, MAY appoint the county road
- 12 commissioners. -, except as provided in subsection (2). A county
- 13 road commissioner appointed <u>in that county</u> UNDER THIS SUBSECTION
- 14 shall not be removed from office before the expiration of his or
- 15 her term of office without being given -due- written notice of the
- 16 charges made against him or her and an opportunity to appear before
- 17 the county board of commissioners for a hearing on the charges. -In
- 18 any county in which the board of road commissioners consists on
- 19 August 28, 1929, of less than 3 members, the county board of
- 20 commissioners, at the first regular meeting of the board after
- 21 August 28, 1929, or at a special meeting called for that purpose,
- 22 shall appoint additional members as may be necessary. At the time
- 23 of the appointment, the county board of commissioners shall
- 24 designate the date of expiration of the initial term of each
- 25 commissioner appointed in that county, so that the term of a
- 26 commissioner shall expire on December 31 of each even year.
- 27 (5) -(2) In a county having a population of 1,500,000 or more

- 12 (6) THE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MAY INCREASE OR DECREASE
- 13 THE NUMBER OF COUNTY ROAD COMMISSIONERS AS ALLOWED UNDER THIS
- 14 SECTION IF THE COUNTY [BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS RECEIVES A RESOLUTION FROM
- THE COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION REQUESTING THE INCREASE OR DECREASE. THE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS SHALL CONFIRM OR DENY THE RESOLUTION WITHIN 60 BUSINESS DAYS OF RECEIVING THE RESOLUTION. SHOULD THE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FAIL TO ACT WITHIN 60 BUSINESS DAYS OF RECEIVING THE RESOLUTION, THE RESOLUTION SHALL NOT BE CONSIDERED AGREED TO BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AND IT SHALL NOT TAKE EFFECT].
