- 16 (5) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES A QUARANTINE RULE PROMULGATED OR
- 17 OUARANTINE ORDER ISSUED UNDER THIS ACT IS LIABLE FOR ANY DAMAGES TO
- 18 PLANTS, NATURAL RESOURCES, OR AGRICULTURAL, SILVICULTURAL, OR
- 19 HORTICULTURAL PRODUCTS OR RESOURCES RESULTING FROM THE VIOLATION,
- 20 INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, COSTS INCURRED TO INVESTIGATE,
- 21 MONITOR, PREVENT, OR MINIMIZE SUCH DAMAGES.
