

**SUBSTITUTE FOR
HOUSE BILL NO. 4643**

A bill to amend 1927 PA 372, entitled

"An act to regulate and license the selling, purchasing, possessing, and carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices; to prohibit the buying, selling, or carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices without a license or other authorization; to provide for the forfeiture of firearms under certain circumstances; to provide for penalties and remedies; to provide immunity from civil liability under certain circumstances; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies; to prohibit certain conduct against individuals who apply for or receive a license to carry a concealed pistol; to make appropriations; to prescribe certain conditions for the appropriations; and to repeal all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act,"

by amending section 5/ (MCL 28.425/), as amended by 2002 PA 719.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5/. (1) A license to carry a concealed pistol issued
2 before July 1, 2003 is valid for 3 years and a license to carry a
3 concealed pistol issued on or after July 1, 2003 is valid for 5

1 years. A renewal of a license under section 5b shall, **EXCEPT AS**
2 **PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION**, be issued in the same manner as an
3 original license issued under section 5b.

4 (2) The educational requirements under section 5b(7)(c) are
5 waived for an applicant who is a retired police officer or retired
6 law enforcement officer.

7 (3) The educational requirements under section 5b(7)(c) for an
8 applicant who is applying for a renewal of a license under this act
9 are waived except that the applicant shall certify that he or she
10 has completed at least 3 hours' review of the training described
11 under section 5b(7)(c) and has had at least 1 hour of firing range
12 time in the 6 months immediately preceding the subsequent
13 application.

14 (4) **THE CONCEALED WEAPON LICENSING BOARD SHALL ISSUE OR DENY**
15 **ISSUANCE OF A RENEWAL LICENSE WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER THE APPLICATION**
16 **FOR RENEWAL IS PROPERLY SUBMITTED. THE COUNTY CLERK SHALL ISSUE THE**
17 **APPLICANT A RECEIPT FOR HIS OR HER RENEWAL APPLICATION AT THE TIME**
18 **THE APPLICATION IS SUBMITTED. THE RECEIPT SHALL STATE THE TIME AND**
19 **DATE OF APPLICATION. IF THE CONCEALED WEAPON LICENSING BOARD DOES**
20 **NOT ISSUE OR DENY ISSUANCE OF A RENEWAL LICENSE WITHIN THE 60-DAY**
21 **PERIOD, THE PERIOD FOR THE ORIGINAL LICENSE IS EXTENDED FOR 180**
22 **DAYS OR UNTIL A RENEWAL LICENSE IS ISSUED OR DENIED, WHICHEVER**
23 **OCCURS FIRST. A PERSON CARRYING A CONCEALED PISTOL PURSUANT TO THIS**
24 **SUBSECTION AFTER THE EXPIRATION DATE OF HIS OR HER LICENSE SHALL**
25 **KEEP THE RECEIPT ISSUED BY THE COUNTY CLERK AND HIS OR HER EXPIRED**
26 **LICENSE IN HIS OR HER POSSESSION AT ALL TIMES THAT HE OR SHE IS**
27 **CARRYING THE PISTOL. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS ACT, THE RECEIPT IS**

- 1 CONSIDERED TO BE PART OF THE LICENSE TO CARRY A CONCEALED PISTOL
- 2 UNTIL A RENEWAL LICENSE IS ISSUED OR DENIED. FAILING TO HAVE THE
- 3 RECEIPT AND EXPIRED LICENSE IN POSSESSION WHILE CARRYING A
- 4 CONCEALED PISTOL OR FAILING TO DISPLAY THE RECEIPT TO A PEACE
- 5 OFFICER UPON REQUEST IS A VIOLATION OF THIS ACT. [A RECEIPT ISSUED UNDER
THIS SUBSECTION SHALL CONTAIN ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
 - (A) THE NAME OF THE LICENSEE.
 - (B) THE DATE THE RECEIPT IS ISSUED.
 - (C) THE AMOUNT PAID.
 - (D) A STATEMENT THAT THE RECEIPT IS FOR A LICENSE RENEWAL.
 - (E) THE NAME OF THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE RECEIPT IS ISSUED.
 - (F) AN IMPRESSION OF THE COUNTY SEAL.]
