SUBSTITUTE FOR

HOUSE BILL NO. 4929

A bill to amend 1937 (Ex Sess) PA 4, entitled

"An act relative to continuing tenure of office of certificated teachers in public educational institutions; to provide for probationary periods; to regulate discharges or demotions; to provide for resignations and leaves of absence; to create a state tenure commission and to prescribe the powers and duties thereof; and to prescribe penalties for violation of the provisions of this act,"

by amending section 1 of article IV (MCL 38.101), as amended by 1993 PA 60, and by adding section 1a to article IV.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 ARTICLE IV
- 2 Sec. 1. —Discharge— EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SECTION 1A
- 3 OF THIS ARTICLE, DISCHARGE or demotion of a teacher on continuing
- 4 tenure may be made only for reasonable and just cause and only as
- 5 provided in this act. This act does not prevent any controlling

- 1 board from establishing a reasonable policy for retirement to apply
- 2 equally to all teachers who are eligible for retirement under the
- 3 public school employees retirement act of 1979, -Act No. 300 of the
- 4 Public Acts of 1980, being sections 38.1301 to 38.1408 of the
- 5 Michigan Compiled Laws 1980 PA 300, MCL 38.1301 TO 38.1408, or,
- 6 having established a reasonable retirement age policy, from
- 7 temporarily continuing on a year-to-year basis on criteria equally
- 8 applied to all teachers the contract of any teacher whom the
- 9 controlling board might wish to retain beyond the established
- 10 retirement age for the benefit of the school system.
- 11 SEC. 1A. THE RIGHTS OF A TEACHER ON CONTINUING TENURE UNDER
- 12 THIS ARTICLE ARE SUBJECT TO SECTIONS 1230D AND 1535A OF THE REVISED
- 13 SCHOOL CODE, 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.1230D AND 380.1535A. TO THE
- 14 EXTENT THAT ANY PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE IS INCONSISTENT WITH
- 15 THOSE SECTIONS OF LAW, THIS ARTICLE DOES NOT APPLY TO THE TEACHER.
