## **HOUSE BILL No. 5082**

August 10, 2005, Introduced by Rep. Drolet and referred to the Committee on House Oversight, Elections, and Ethics.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

by amending section 686 (MCL 168.686), as amended by 2003 PA 284.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 686. (1) Within 24 hours after the conclusion of the
- 2 state convention before a general election, the state central
- 3 committee of each political party shall canvass the proceedings of
- 4 the convention and determine the nominees of the convention. Not
- 5 more than 1 business day after the state convention, the
- 5 chairperson and secretary of the state central committee shall
- forward to the secretary of state, a typewritten or printed list of
- the names and residence, including the street address if known, of

- 1 all candidates nominated at the state convention.
- 2 (2) In each presidential election year, the state central
- 3 committee of each MAJOR political party shall, not more than 1
- 4 business day after the state convention or the national convention
- 5 of that party, whichever is later, forward to the secretary of
- 6 state the typewritten or printed names of the candidates of that
- 7 party for the offices of president of the United States and vice-
- 8 president of the United States certified to by the chairperson and
- 9 secretary of the committees.
- 10 (3) IN EACH PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION YEAR, THE STATE CENTRAL
- 11 COMMITTEE OF EACH MINOR POLITICAL PARTY SHALL, AFTER THE STATE
- 12 CONVENTION OR THE NATIONAL CONVENTION OF THAT PARTY, WHICHEVER IS
- 13 LATER, AND NOT LESS THAN 60 DAYS BEFORE THE GENERAL ELECTION,
- 14 FORWARD TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE THE TYPEWRITTEN OR PRINTED NAMES
- 15 OF THE CANDIDATES OF THAT PARTY FOR THE OFFICES OF PRESIDENT OF THE
- 16 UNITED STATES AND VICE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES CERTIFIED TO
- 17 BY THE CHAIRPERSON AND SECRETARY OF THE COMMITTEES.
- 18 (4) A party is not required to certify nominations made at an
- 19 official primary election.
- 20 (5) The secretary of state shall forward a copy of a list
- 21 received under this section to the board of election commissioners
- 22 of each county, in care of the county clerk at the county seat.
- 23 (6) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "MINOR POLITICAL PARTY" MEANS
- 24 THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 10 OF THE MICHIGAN CAMPAIGN FINANCE
