

SUBSTITUTE FOR  
HOUSE BILL NO. 5132

A bill to amend 1982 PA 540, entitled  
"Library of Michigan act,"  
by amending section 9 (MCL 397.19), as amended by 1983 PA 114.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1       Sec. 9. (1) The library shall serve as a depository for each  
2 public document issued by a state official, department, board,  
3 commission, or agency. Not less than ~~75~~ 15 copies of each  
4 document or 1 copy in the proper format as determined by the state  
5 librarian which is not issued solely for the use of a state  
6 official, department, board, commission, or agency shall be  
7 furnished to the library. Additional copies of those documents  
8 shall be supplied upon the request of the state librarian. **A STATE**  
9 **OFFICIAL, DEPARTMENT, BOARD, COMMISSION, OR AGENCY DOES NOT HAVE TO**

1 FILE PAPER COPIES OF A DOCUMENT AS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION  
2 IF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY:

3 (A) THE DOCUMENT IS AVAILABLE FOR FREE ON THE STATE OF  
4 MICHIGAN INTERNET WEBSITE.

5 (B) THE STATE LIBRARIAN IS GIVEN NOTICE OF THE DOCUMENT'S  
6 AVAILABILITY ON THE STATE OF MICHIGAN INTERNET WEBSITE.

7 (C) THE NOTICE PROVIDED UNDER SUBDIVISION (B) INCLUDES THE  
8 INTERNET WEBSITE ADDRESS WHERE THE DOCUMENT CAN BE LOCATED.

9 (D) PRINTED COPIES OF THE DOCUMENT ARE NOT PRODUCED.

10 (E) THE DOCUMENT IS IN A NONPROPRIETARY FORMAT.

11 (2) A publication of a school, college, division, or  
12 department of a state supported college or university **THAT IS**  
13 **AVAILABLE FOR FREE OVER THE INTERNET** is exempt from the PAPER COPY  
14 depository requirements of subsection (1), except that 2 copies of  
15 each publication **NOT AVAILABLE FOR FREE ON THE SCHOOL'S INTERNET**  
16 **WEBSITE** shall be deposited in the library.

17 (3) A publication of a state supported college or university  
18 press, directive for internal administration, an intraoffice or  
19 interoffice memorandum, a state form, or other correspondence is  
20 exempt from the depository requirements of subsection (1).

21 (4) THE STATE LIBRARIAN SHALL PROVIDE WRITTEN NOTICE OF  
22 NONCOMPLIANCE TO ANY STATE OFFICIAL, DEPARTMENT, BOARD, COMMISSION,  
23 AGENCY, COLLEGE, OR UNIVERSITY THAT HAS FAILED TO COMPLY WITH THIS  
24 SECTION. THE STATE LIBRARIAN SHALL INFORM THE GOVERNOR AND THE  
25 ATTORNEY GENERAL IF COMPLIANCE IS NOT ACHIEVED BY A DATE SPECIFIED  
26 IN THE NOTICE.
