SUBSTITUTE FOR

HOUSE BILL NO. 5302

A bill to amend 1986 PA 102, entitled

"An act to establish a grant program for certain part-time, independent students in this state; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies and institutions of higher education,"

by amending section 3 (MCL 390.1283), as amended by 2004 PA 180.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3. A person is eligible to participate in the grant
- 2 program if he or she meets all of the following:
- 3 (a) Is a part-time student.
- 4 (b) Is an independent student.
- 5 (c) Has not been enrolled in a high school diploma program
- 6 other than general educational development (GED) or adult education
- 7 for at least the 2 preceding years.
- 8 (d) Is enrolled or accepted for enrollment in an undergraduate

- 1 program of not less than 9 months duration leading to a degree or
- 2 certificate from a Michigan degree granting educational institution
- 3 that is approved by the department of labor and economic growth.
- 4 (e) Has resided continuously in this state for the immediately
- 5 preceding 12 months and is not considered a resident of any other
- 6 state.
- 7 (f) Is not incarcerated in a corrections institution.
- 8 (g) Has complied with this act and the rules promulgated under
- **9** this act by the authority.
- 10 (h) Is a United States citizen or permanent resident.
- 11 (H) IS A UNITED STATES CITIZEN OR ANY OTHER STUDENT DESCRIBED
- 12 AS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE TITLE IV, HEA PROGRAM ASSISTANCE UNDER 34
- 13 CFR 668.33.
- 14 (i) Is not enrolled in an institution whose primary purpose is
- 15 to prepare students for ordination or appointment as a member of
- 16 the clergy of a church, denomination, or religious association,
- 17 order, or sect.
- 18 (j) Is not in default on a loan guaranteed by the authority.
- 19 (k) Is shown by the school to be making satisfactory academic
- 20 progress.
- 21 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 22 unless all of the following bills of the 93rd Legislature are
