- 8 (C) -(b) Has not graduated from high school at the time of
- 9 the scholarship examination.

- 2 institution within 4 years after graduation from high school.
- 3 (E) $\frac{-(d)}{}$ Is not enrolled in an institution whose primary
- 4 purpose is to prepare students for ordination or appointment as a
- 5 member of the clergy of a church, denomination, or religious
- 6 association, order, or sect.
