SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4108

(As amended, May 10, 2006)

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled "Revised judicature act of 1961,"

(MCL 600.101 to 600.9947) by adding section 2976.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 2976. (1) A SELLER OR END USER WHO STORES, SECURES, USES,
- 2 TRANSPORTS, OR PROTECTS ANHYDROUS AMMONIA IN COMPLIANCE WITH AASSPS
- 3 IS IMMUNE FROM TORT LIABILITY FOR INJURY TO A PERSON, DAMAGE TO
- 4 PROPERTY, OR DEATH THAT RESULTS FROM THE LARCENY OR ATTEMPTED
- 5 LARCENY OF ANHYDROUS AMMONIA, OR FROM A PERSON OBTAINING OR USING,
- 6 OR ATTEMPTING TO OBTAIN OR USE, ANHYDROUS AMMONIA IN A MANNER
- 7 CONTRARY TO LAW. THE IMMUNITY FROM TORT LIABILITY UNDER THIS
- 8 SUBSECTION INCLUDES IMMUNITY FROM LIABILITY FOR AN INJURY TO,
- 9 DAMAGE TO THE PROPERTY OF, OR THE DEATH OF A PERSON WHO IS NOT THE

- 1 PERSON COMMITTING OR ATTEMPTING TO COMMIT A LARCENY OF, OR
- 2 OBTAINING, USING, OR ATTEMPTING TO OBTAIN OR USE, ANHYDROUS AMMONIA
- 3 IN A MANNER CONTRARY TO LAW.
- (2) FAILURE OF A SELLER OR END USER TO STORE, SECURE, USE, 4
- 5 TRANSPORT, OR PROTECT ANHYDROUS AMMONIA IN COMPLIANCE WITH AASSPS
- DOES NOT, BY ITSELF, CREATE TORT LIABILITY FOR INJURY TO PERSON,
- 7 DAMAGE TO PROPERTY, OR DEATH CAUSED BY THE STORING, SECURING,
- USING, TRANSPORTING, OR PROTECTING OF ANHYDROUS AMMONIA. 8
- (3) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO A CAUSE OF ACTION THAT ACCRUES 9
- AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS 10
- 11 SECTION AND AFTER AASSPS ARE ESTABLISHED UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE
- 12 ANHYDROUS AMMONIA SECURITY ACT.
- (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "AASSPS", "ANHYDROUS AMMONIA", 13
- "END USER", AND "SELLER" MEAN THOSE TERMS AS DEFINED IN SECTION 3 14
- OF THE ANHYDROUS AMMONIA SECURITY ACT. 15
- 16 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 17 unless Senate Bill No. 877 of the 93rd Legislature is enacted into
