SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4357

A bill to amend 2004 PA 438, entitled

"An act to designate Police Officers Memorial Day in the state of Michigan,"

by amending the title and sections 1 and 2 (MCL 435.351 and 435.352).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 TITLE
- 2 An act to designate MAY 15 OF EACH YEAR AS Police Officers
- 3 Memorial Day in the state of Michigan; AND TO DESIGNATE SEPTEMBER
- 4 11 OF EACH YEAR AS FIREFIGHTERS MEMORIAL DAY IN THE STATE OF
- 5 MICHIGAN.
- 6 Sec. 1. (1) In recognition of the men and women who have lost
- 7 their lives in the line of duty while serving as law enforcement
- 8 officers in the state of Michigan, May 15 of each year shall be

- 1 known as "Police Officers Memorial Day".
- 2 (2) IN RECOGNITION OF THE MEN AND WOMEN WHO HAVE LOST THEIR
- 3 LIVES WHILE SERVING AS FIREFIGHTERS IN THE STATE OF MICHIGAN,
- 4 SEPTEMBER 11 OF EACH YEAR SHALL BE KNOWN AS "FIREFIGHTERS MEMORIAL
- 5 DAY".
- 6 Sec. 2. On this day THESE DAYS, all flags at public
- 7 buildings shall be lowered to half staff in honor and appreciation
- 8 of fallen law enforcement officers AND FIREFIGHTERS. Each community
- 9 throughout the state is encouraged to conduct a memorial ceremony,
- 10 and the state's citizens are encouraged to pause and reflect on the
- 11 dedicated professionals who bravely chose to accept personal risk
- 12 and made the ultimate sacrifice while protecting and defending the
- 13 public.
