## SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4643

## A bill to amend 1927 PA 372, entitled

"An act to regulate and license the selling, purchasing, possessing, and carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices; to prohibit the buying, selling, or carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices without a license or other authorization; to provide for the forfeiture of firearms under certain circumstances; to provide for penalties and remedies; to provide immunity from civil liability under certain circumstances; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies; to prohibit certain conduct against individuals who apply for or receive a license to carry a concealed pistol; to make appropriations; to prescribe certain conditions for the appropriations; and to repeal all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act,"

by amending section 5l (MCL 28.425l), as amended by 2005 PA 262.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5l. (1) A license to carry a concealed pistol issued
- 2 before July 1, 2003 is valid for 3 years and a license to carry a
- 3 concealed pistol issued on or after July 1, 2003 is valid for 5

- 1 years. A license that is renewed before the immediately preceding
- 2 license term expires, but not more than 1 year before the
- 3 immediately preceding license term expires, shall bear an issue
- 4 date that is identical to the expiration date of the preceding
- 5 license. A renewal of a license under section 5b shall, EXCEPT AS
- 6 PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, be issued in the same manner as an
- 7 original license issued under section 5b.
- 8 (2) THE CONCEALED WEAPON LICENSING BOARD SHALL ISSUE OR DENY
- 9 ISSUANCE OF A RENEWAL LICENSE WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER THE APPLICATION
- 10 FOR RENEWAL IS PROPERLY SUBMITTED. THE COUNTY CLERK SHALL ISSUE THE
- 11 APPLICANT A RECEIPT FOR HIS OR HER RENEWAL APPLICATION AT THE TIME
- 12 THE APPLICATION IS SUBMITTED. THE RECEIPT SHALL STATE THE TIME AND
- 13 DATE OF APPLICATION.
- 14 (3) IF THE CONCEALED WEAPON LICENSING BOARD FAILS TO DENY OR
- 15 ISSUE A RENEWAL LICENSE TO THE PERSON WITHIN 60 DAYS AS REQUIRED
- 16 UNDER SUBSECTION (2), THE EXPIRATION DATE OF THE CURRENT LICENSE IS
- 17 EXTENDED BY 180 DAYS OR UNTIL THE RENEWAL LICENSE IS ISSUED,
- 18 WHICHEVER OCCURS FIRST. THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY UNLESS THE
- 19 PERSON PAYS THE RENEWAL FEE AT THE TIME THE RENEWAL APPLICATION IS
- 20 SUBMITTED AND THE PERSON HAS SUBMITTED A RECEIPT THAT CONFIRMS THAT
- 21 A BACKGROUND CHECK HAS BEEN REQUESTED BY THE APPLICANT.
- 22 (4) A PERSON CARRYING A CONCEALED PISTOL AFTER THE EXPIRATION
- 23 DATE OF HIS OR HER LICENSE PURSUANT TO AN EXTENSION UNDER
- 24 SUBSECTION (3) SHALL KEEP THE RECEIPT ISSUED BY THE COUNTY CLERK
- 25 AND HIS OR HER EXPIRED LICENSE IN HIS OR HER POSSESSION AT ALL
- 26 TIMES THAT HE OR SHE IS CARRYING THE PISTOL. FOR THE PURPOSES OF
- 27 THIS ACT, THE RECEIPT IS CONSIDERED TO BE PART OF THE LICENSE TO

- 1 CARRY A CONCEALED PISTOL UNTIL A RENEWAL LICENSE IS ISSUED OR
- 2 DENIED. FAILING TO HAVE THE RECEIPT AND EXPIRED LICENSE IN
- 3 POSSESSION WHILE CARRYING A CONCEALED PISTOL OR FAILING TO DISPLAY
- 4 THE RECEIPT TO A PEACE OFFICER UPON REQUEST IS A VIOLATION OF THIS
- 5 ACT. A RECEIPT ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL CONTAIN ALL OF
- 6 THE FOLLOWING:
- 7 (A) THE NAME OF THE LICENSEE.
- 8 (B) THE DATE THE RECEIPT IS ISSUED.
- 9 (C) THE AMOUNT PAID.
- 10 (D) A STATEMENT THAT THE RECEIPT IS FOR A LICENSE RENEWAL.
- 11 (E) THE NAME OF THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE RECEIPT IS ISSUED.
- 12 (F) AN IMPRESSION OF THE COUNTY SEAL.
- 13 (5)  $\frac{(2)}{(2)}$  The educational requirements under section 5b(7)(c)
- 14 are waived for an applicant who is a retired police officer or
- 15 retired law enforcement officer.
- 16 (6) -(3) The educational requirements under section 5b(7)(c)
- 17 for an applicant who is applying for a renewal of a license under
- 18 this act are waived except that the applicant shall certify that he
- 19 or she has completed at least 3 hours' review of the training
- 20 described under section 5b(7)(c) and has had at least 1 hour of
- 21 firing range time in the 6 months immediately preceding the
- 22 subsequent application.
- 23 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect July 1,
