## SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4918

A bill to amend 1968 PA 357, entitled

"An act to prescribe the powers, duties and functions of the state officers' compensation commission; and to prescribe the powers and duties of the legislature in relation to the commission,"

by amending section 7 (MCL 15.217).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 7. The determinations of the commission shall be
- 2 effective January 1 of the year following their filing and shall be
- 3 the compensation and expense allowances of the governor, lieutenant
- 4 governor, justices of the supreme court and members of the
- 5 legislature unless the legislature, by concurrent resolution
- 6 adopted by a 2/3 vote of the members elected to and serving prior
- 7 to February 1 of the year following the filing of the
- 8 determinations, rejects either the entire determinations or

- 1 specific determinations for specific positions. In case of
- 2 rejection the existing salary and expense allowances shall prevail
- retroactive to January 1. THE SALARIES AND EXPENSE ALLOWANCES ONLY 3
- IF THE LEGISLATURE BY CONCURRENT RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY A MAJORITY
- OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED TO AND SERVING IN EACH HOUSE OF THE 5
- LEGISLATURE APPROVE THEM. THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
- SHALL ALTERNATE ON WHICH HOUSE OF THE LEGISLATURE SHALL ORIGINATE 7
- THE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION, WITH THE SENATE ORIGINATING THE FIRST 8
- CONCURRENT RESOLUTION IN 2009. THE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION MAY AMEND 9
- THE SALARY AND EXPENSE DETERMINATIONS OF THE STATE OFFICERS 10
- 11 COMPENSATION COMMISSION TO REDUCE THE SALARY AND EXPENSE
- 12 DETERMINATIONS BY THE SAME PROPORTION FOR THE MEMBERS OF THE
- LEGISLATURE, THE GOVERNOR, THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR, THE ATTORNEY 13
- GENERAL, THE SECRETARY OF STATE, AND THE JUSTICES OF THE SUPREME 14
- COURT. THE LEGISLATURE SHALL NOT AMEND THE SALARY AND EXPENSE 15
- DETERMINATIONS TO REDUCE THEM TO BELOW THE SALARY AND EXPENSE LEVEL 16
- THAT THE MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE, THE GOVERNOR, THE LIEUTENANT 17
- GOVERNOR, THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, THE SECRETARY OF STATE, AND THE 18
- 19 JUSTICES OF THE SUPREME COURT RECEIVE ON THE DATE THE SALARY AND
- EXPENSE DETERMINATIONS ARE MADE. IF THE SALARY AND EXPENSE 20
- DETERMINATIONS ARE APPROVED OR AMENDED AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, 21
- THE SALARY AND EXPENSE DETERMINATIONS SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE FOR 22
- 23 THE REGULAR LEGISLATIVE SESSION IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE NEXT
- 24 GENERAL ELECTION.
- 25 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect January
- 26 1, 2008.
