THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5927. (1) The department shall utilize the fund to
- 2 develop educational programs for health care workers, whether
- 3 licensed or not, regarding the delivery of quality care and
- 4 protection against exposure to disease in the workplace.
- 5 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL UTILIZE THE FUND TO MAKE AVAILABLE
