A bill to amend 1976 PA 390, entitled
"Emergency management act,"

(MCL 30.401 to 30.421) by amending the title, as amended by 1990 PA
50, and by adding section 11a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 TITLE 2 An act to provide for planning, mitigation, response, and 3 recovery from natural and human-made disaster within AND OUTSIDE 4 this state; to create the Michigan emergency management advisory 5 council and prescribe its powers and duties; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies and 6 7 officials; to prescribe immunities and liabilities; to provide for 8 the acceptance of gifts; AND to repeal -certain acts and parts of

- 1 acts. ; and to repeal certain parts of the act.
- 2 SEC. 11A. (1) A STATE EMPLOYEE WHO IS NOT IN THE STATE
- 3 CLASSIFIED CIVIL SERVICE AND WHO IS SKILLED IN EMERGENCY RELIEF
- 4 ASSISTANCE AND CERTIFIED AS A DISASTER SERVICES VOLUNTEER BY THE
- 5 AMERICAN RED CROSS MAY BE GRANTED AN UNPAID LEAVE OF ABSENCE FROM
- 6 HIS OR HER STATE EMPLOYMENT TO PROVIDE DISASTER OR EMERGENCY RELIEF
- 7 ASSISTANCE IN THIS STATE.
- 8 (2) A STATE EMPLOYEE IN THE STATE CLASSIFIED CIVIL SERVICE WHO
- 9 IS SKILLED IN EMERGENCY RELIEF ASSISTANCE AND CERTIFIED AS A
- 10 DISASTER SERVICES VOLUNTEER BY THE AMERICAN RED CROSS MAY BE
- 11 GRANTED A LEAVE OF ABSENCE FROM HIS OR HER CLASSIFIED EMPLOYMENT TO
- 12 PROVIDE DISASTER OR EMERGENCY RELIEF ASSISTANCE IN THIS STATE AS
- 13 AUTHORIZED BY THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION.
- 14 (3) IN ADDITION TO UNPAID LEAVE UNDER SUBSECTION (1) OR (2),
- 15 AN EMPLOYEE OF AN AGENCY IN ANY BRANCH OF STATE GOVERNMENT WHO IS
- 16 SKILLED IN EMERGENCY RELIEF ASSISTANCE AND CERTIFIED AS A DISASTER
- 17 SERVICES VOLUNTEER BY THE AMERICAN RED CROSS MAY BE GRANTED LEAVE
- 18 FROM WORK WITH PAY FOR NOT MORE THAN 10 DAYS IN ANY 12-MONTH PERIOD
- 19 TO PARTICIPATE IN SPECIALIZED DISASTER RELIEF SERVICES WITHIN OR
- 20 OUTSIDE OF THIS STATE IF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING CIRCUMSTANCES ARE
- 21 PRESENT:
- 22 (A) THE GOVERNOR OR THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES HAS
- 23 DECLARED THE DISASTER.
- 24 (B) THE AMERICAN RED CROSS HAS REQUESTED THE SERVICES OF THE
- 25 EMPLOYEE.
- 26 (C) THE EMPLOYEE'S DEPARTMENT HEAD HAS APPROVED THE LEAVE.
- 27 (D) IF THE SERVICES ARE RENDERED OUTSIDE THE STATE BY AN

- EMPLOYEE IN THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH, THE GOVERNOR HAS APPROVED THE 1
- 2 LEAVE.
- 3 (E) IF THE EMPLOYEE IS IN THE STATE CLASSIFIED CIVIL SERVICE,
- 4 THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION HAS APPROVED THE LEAVE.
- 5 (4) NOT MORE THAN 50 STATE EMPLOYEES SHALL BE GRANTED PAID
- 6 LEAVE UNDER SUBSECTION (3) DURING THE FISCAL YEAR. THE GOVERNOR MAY
- INCREASE THE LIMIT ON THE NUMBER OF STATE EMPLOYEES WHO MAY BE 7
- 8 GRANTED PAID DISASTER LEAVE DURING THE FISCAL YEAR BY EXECUTIVE
- 9 ORDER.
- 10 (5) THIS STATE SHALL NOT PENALIZE OR OTHERWISE TAKE ADVERSE
- 11 EMPLOYMENT ACTION AGAINST A STATE EMPLOYEE BECAUSE THE EMPLOYEE
- 12 TAKES A LEAVE OF ABSENCE AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS SECTION TO PROVIDE
- DISASTER OR EMERGENCY RELIEF ASSISTANCE. HOWEVER, THE STATE SHALL 13
- 14 RECOVER PAYMENT FOR PAID DISASTER LEAVE FROM AN EMPLOYEE WHO IS
- 15 GRANTED PAID LEAVE UNDER SUBSECTION (3) IF THE EMPLOYEE DOES NOT
- 16 USE THE LEAVE TIME FOR THE APPROVED PURPOSE.
