## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5307

## A bill to amend 1966 PA 313, entitled

"An act to award tuition grants to resident students enrolled in independent nonprofit institutions of higher learning; and to make an appropriation therefor,"

by amending section 3 (MCL 390.993), as amended by 1980 PA 503.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3. (1) Upon **RECEIPT OF AN** application, of an eligible
- 2 resident student, who has resided in this state continuously for
- 3 the preceding 12 months, is not considered a resident of any other
- 4 state, is not incarcerated in a corrections institution, and is
- 5 registered in an independent nonprofit college or university in
- 6 this state, as described in section 1, the Michigan higher
- 7 education assistance authority shall grant an amount as provided

- 1 for in this act for each semester of attendance TO AN ELIGIBLE
- 2 RESIDENT STUDENT WHO MEETS ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 3 (A) IS A UNITED STATES CITIZEN OR ANY OTHER STUDENT DESCRIBED
- 4 AS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE TITLE IV, HEA PROGRAM ASSISTANCE UNDER 34
- 5 CFR 668.33.
- 6 (B) HAS RESIDED IN THIS STATE CONTINUOUSLY FOR THE 12 MONTHS
- 7 PRECEDING THE APPLICATION.
- 8 (C) IS NOT CONSIDERED A RESIDENT OF ANY OTHER STATE.
- 9 (D) IS NOT INCARCERATED IN A CORRECTIONS INSTITUTION.
- 10 (E) IS ENROLLED IN AN INDEPENDENT NONPROFIT COLLEGE OR
- 11 UNIVERSITY IN THIS STATE DESCRIBED IN SECTION 1.
- 12 (2) A student shall not be IS NOT eligible for a grant for
- 13 tuition and fees for more than 10 semesters of undergraduate
- 14 education, or its equivalent in trimesters, or equivalent as
- 15 determined by the authority for less than full-time students; in
- 16 not more than 6 semesters of graduate education, or its equivalent
- 17 in trimesters; and in not more than 8 semesters in dental
- 18 education, or its equivalent in trimesters.
- 19 (3) —(2)— A student —shall— MUST maintain satisfactory
- 20 academic progress, as defined by the college or university in which
- 21 the student is enrolled, in order to remain eligible for -the- A
- 22 tuition grant under this act.
- 23 (4) -(3)— If a student possessing a degree at a given academic
- 24 level enrolls for a second degree at the same academic level, the
- 25 authority shall include tuition grants received by the student when
- 26 enrolled for the previous degree at the same level in determining
- 27 the student's eligibility pursuant to UNDER subsection (1).
