

# HOUSE BILL No. 5658

February 8, 2006, Introduced by Reps. Cushingberry, Lipsey, Lemmons, Jr., Cheeks, David Law, Meisner, Kolb, Bieda, Condino, Adamini, Whitmer, Gaffney, Vagnozzi, Miller, Kahn, Sak, Sheltrown and Lemmons, III and referred to the Committee on Local Government and Urban Policy.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled  
"The code of criminal procedure,"  
by amending section 18 of chapter XVII (MCL 777.18), as amended  
by 2000 PA 304.

**1 CHAPTER XVII**

**2 Sec. 18. This chapter applies to the following felonies:**
