- 8 (J) "SERVICES" MEANS AN ONGOING RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN A PERSON
- 9 AND ANOTHER PERSON IN WHICH THE OTHER PERSON PERFORMS ACTIVITIES
- 10 UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF OR FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE PERSON,
- 11 INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, COMMERCIAL SEXUAL ACTIVITY AND

- 26 OTHER ACTUAL OR PURPORTED GOVERNMENT IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENT, OF
- 27 ANOTHER PERSON. EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTIONS (2) AND (3), A

- 13 PERSON. EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTIONS (2) AND (3), A PERSON WHO
- 14 VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY
- 15 IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 10 YEARS.
- 16 (2) IF IN THE VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (1) THE PERSON CAUSES
- 17 ANOTHER PERSON INJURY, THE PERSON IS GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE

- 22 SEC. 462G. A PERSON SHALL NOT KNOWINGLY RECRUIT, ENTICE,
- 23 HARBOR, TRANSPORT, PROVIDE, OR OBTAIN BY ANY MEANS, OR ATTEMPT TO
- 24 RECRUIT, ENTICE, HARBOR, PROVIDE, OR OBTAIN BY ANY MEANS, A MINOR
- 25 KNOWING THAT THE MINOR WILL BE USED FOR CHILD SEXUALLY ABUSIVE
- 26 ACTIVITY. A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY
- 27 PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 20 YEARS.

- 1 SEC. 462H. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT KNOWINGLY DO 1 OR BOTH OF
- 2 THE FOLLOWING:
- 3 (A) RECRUIT, ENTICE, HARBOR, TRANSPORT, PROVIDE, OR OBTAIN BY
- 4 ANY MEANS, OR ATTEMPT TO RECRUIT, ENTICE, HARBOR, TRANSPORT,
- 5 PROVIDE, OR OBTAIN BY ANY MEANS, ANOTHER PERSON, INTENDING OR
- 6 KNOWING THAT THE PERSON WILL BE SUBJECTED TO FORCED LABOR OR
- 7 SERVICES.
- 8 (B) BENEFIT FINANCIALLY OR RECEIVE ANYTHING OF VALUE FROM
- 9 PARTICIPATION IN A VENTURE THAT HAS ENGAGED IN AN ACT DESCRIBED IN
- 10 THIS CHAPTER.
- 11 (2) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTIONS (3) AND (4), A PERSON
- 12 WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1) IS GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY

- 20 SEC. 4621. IF A VIOLATION OF THIS CHAPTER INVOLVES KIDNAPPING
- 21 OR AN ATTEMPT TO KIDNAP, CRIMINAL SEXUAL CONDUCT OR AN ATTEMPT TO
- 22 COMMIT CRIMINAL SEXUAL CONDUCT, OR AN ATTEMPT TO KILL, THE
- 23 DEFENDANT SHALL BE IMPRISONED FOR LIFE OR ANY TERM OF YEARS.
- 24 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 25 after the date it is enacted.
