A bill to amend 1967 PA 227, entitled

"An act to regulate the inspection, construction, installation, alteration, maintenance, repair and operation of elevators and the licensing of elevator contractors; to prescribe the functions of the director of labor; to create, and prescribe the functions of, the elevator safety board; to provide penalties for violations of the act; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

by amending section 20 (MCL 408.820).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 20. (1) It is unlawful for a A person to SHALL NOT smoke or to carry lighted tobacco in any form in a passenger elevator in any building, structure, or premises in this state. A person having WHO HAS control or management of any building, structure, or premises equipped with a passenger elevator shall not permit smoking or the carrying of lighted tobacco in any form in
