SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5956

A bill to amend 1945 PA 231, entitled

"An act to prescribe additional regulations and requirements for pawnbrokers, secondhand dealers and junk dealers; to provide for the taking of fingerprints and the making of reports to enforcement officers; to prescribe penalties for the violation of the provisions of this act; and to declare the effect of this act,"

by amending sections 1 and 6 (MCL 445.471 and 445.476).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. (1) This act shall be construed as supplementing the
- 2 laws of this state and city and village ordinances and charters
- 3 regulating OR LICENSING pawnbrokers, secondhand dealers, and junk
- 4 dealers.
- 5 (2) The term "secondhand AS USED IN THIS ACT:
- 6 (A) "SECONDHAND dealer" or "junk dealer" as used in this act
- 7 shall mean MEANS any person, corporation, or member or members of

- 1 a co-partnership or firm, whose principal business is that of
- 2 purchasing, storing, selling, exchanging, and receiving -second
- 3 hand SECONDHAND personal property of any kind or description. The
- 4 term "pawnbroker" as used in this act shall mean SECONDHAND DEALER
- 5 OR JUNK DEALER DOES NOT INCLUDE A SCRAP PROCESSOR OR AN AUTOMOTIVE
- 6 RECYCLER.
- 7 (B) "PAWNBROKER" MEANS any person, corporation, or member or
- 8 members of a co-partnership or firm, who loans money on deposit or
- 9 pledge of personal property, or other valuable thing, other than
- 10 securities or printed evidence of indebtedness, or who deals in the
- 11 purchasing of personal property or other valuable thing on
- 12 condition of selling the same back again at a stipulated price.
- 13 (C) "INTERNET DROP-OFF STORE" MEANS A PERSON, CORPORATION, OR
- 14 FIRM THAT CONTRACTS WITH OTHER PERSONS, CORPORATIONS, OR FIRMS TO
- 15 OFFER ITS PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER VALUABLE THING FOR SALE,
- 16 PURCHASE, CONSIGNMENT, OR TRADE THROUGH MEANS OF AN INTERNET
- 17 WEBSITE AND MEETS THE CONDITIONS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 6(3).
- 18 (D) "LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY" MEANS THE POLICE AGENCY OF
- 19 THE CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP, OR IF NONE, THE COUNTY SHERIFF OF
- 20 THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE INTERNET DROP-OFF STORE CONDUCTS BUSINESS.
- 21 (E) "SCRAP PROCESSOR" MEANS A PERSON, UTILIZING MACHINERY AND
- 22 EQUIPMENT AND OPERATING FROM A FIXED LOCATION, WHOSE PRINCIPAL
- 23 BUSINESS IS THE PROCESSING AND MANUFACTURING OF IRON, STEEL,
- 24 NONFERROUS METALS, PAPER, PLASTIC, OR GLASS, INTO PREPARED GRADES
- 25 OF PRODUCTS SUITABLE FOR CONSUMPTION BY RECYCLING MILLS AND
- 26 FOUNDRIES.
- 27 (F) "AUTOMOTIVE RECYCLER" MEANS A PERSON WHO ENGAGES IN

- 1 BUSINESS PRIMARILY FOR THE PURPOSE OF SELLING RETAIL SALVAGE
- 2 VEHICLE PARTS AND SECONDARILY FOR THE PURPOSE OF SELLING RETAIL
- 3 SALVAGE MOTOR VEHICLES OR MANUFACTURING OR SELLING A PRODUCT OF
- 4 GRADABLE SCRAP METAL OR A PERSON EMPLOYED AS A SALVAGE VEHICLE
- 5 AGENT AS THAT TERM IS DEFINED IN SECTION 56C OF THE MICHIGAN
- 6 VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.56C.
- 7 Sec. 6. (1) Nothing in this act shall be deemed to THIS ACT
- 8 DOES NOT apply to any secondhand or junk dealer purchasing scrap
- 9 iron and metal. -, except scrapped motor vehicles not purchased
- 10 from a licensed second hand or junk dealer.
- 11 (2) THIS ACT DOES NOT REQUIRE AN INTERNET DROP-OFF STORE
- 12 COMPLYING WITH SUBSECTION (3), OR A PERSON ENGAGED IN THE SALE,
- 13 PURCHASE, CONSIGNMENT, OR TRADE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER
- 14 VALUABLE THING FOR HIMSELF OR HERSELF, TO OBTAIN A LICENSE UNDER
- 15 THIS ACT OR ANY ORDINANCE BEING SUPPLEMENTED BY THIS ACT.
- 16 (3) AN INTERNET DROP-OFF STORE IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE
- 17 FOLLOWING CONDITIONS IS EXEMPT FROM LICENSURE AS A PAWNBROKER,
- 18 SECONDHAND DEALER, OR JUNK DEALER UNDER THIS ACT:
- 19 (A) HAS A FIXED PLACE OF BUSINESS WITHIN THIS STATE EXCEPT
- 20 THAT HE OR SHE EXCLUSIVELY TRANSACTS ALL PURCHASES OR SALES BY
- 21 MEANS OF THE INTERNET AND THE PURCHASES AND SALES ARE NOT
- 22 PHYSICALLY TRANSACTED ON THE PREMISES OF THAT FIXED PLACE OF
- 23 BUSINESS.
- 24 (B) HAS THE PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER VALUABLE THING
- 25 AVAILABLE ON A WEBSITE FOR VIEWING BY PHOTOGRAPH, IF AVAILABLE, BY
- 26 THE GENERAL PUBLIC AT NO CHARGE, WHICH WEBSITE SHALL BE SEARCHABLE
- 27 BY ZIP CODE OR STATE, OR BOTH. THE WEBSITE VIEWING SHALL INCLUDE,

- 1 AS APPLICABLE, SERIAL NUMBER, MAKE, MODEL, AND OTHER UNIQUE
- 2 IDENTIFYING MARKS, NUMBERS, NAMES, OR LETTERS APPEARING ON THE
- 3 PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER VALUABLE THING.
- 4 (C) MAINTAINS RECORDS OF THE SALE, PURCHASE, CONSIGNMENT, OR
- 5 TRADE OF THE PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER VALUABLE THING FOR AT LEAST
- 6 2 YEARS, WHICH RECORDS SHALL CONTAIN A DESCRIPTION, INCLUDING A
- 7 PHOTOGRAPH, IF AVAILABLE, AND, IF APPLICABLE, SERIAL NUMBER, MAKE,
- 8 MODEL, AND OTHER UNIQUE IDENTIFYING MARKS, NUMBERS, NAMES, OR
- 9 LETTERS APPEARING ON THE PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER VALUABLE THING.
- 10 (D) PROVIDE THE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY WITH ANY NAME
- 11 UNDER WHICH IT CONDUCTS BUSINESS ON THE WEBSITE AND ACCESS TO THE
- 12 BUSINESS PREMISES AT ANY TIME DURING NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS FOR
- 13 PURPOSES OF INSPECTION.
- 14 (E) WITHIN 24 HOURS AFTER A REQUEST FROM A LOCAL LAW
- 15 ENFORCEMENT AGENCY, PROVIDE AN ELECTRONIC COPY OF THE SELLER'S OR
- 16 CONSIGNOR'S NAME, ADDRESS, TELEPHONE NUMBER, DRIVER LICENSE NUMBER
- 17 AND ISSUING STATE, THE BUYER'S NAME AND ADDRESS IF APPLICABLE, AND
- 18 A DESCRIPTION OF THE PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER VALUABLE THING AS
- 19 DESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISION (C). THE PROVISION OF INFORMATION SHALL BE
- 20 IN A FORMAT ACCEPTABLE TO THE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY BUT
- 21 SHALL AT LEAST BE IN A LEGIBLE FORMAT AND IN THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE.
- 22 (F) PROVIDE THAT PAYMENT FOR THE PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER
- 23 VALUABLE THING IS EXECUTED BY MEANS OF CHECK OR OTHER ELECTRONIC
- 24 PAYMENT SYSTEM, SO LONG AS THE PAYMENT IS NOT MADE IN CASH. NO
- 25 PAYMENT SHALL BE PROVIDED TO THE SELLER UNTIL THE ITEM IS SOLD.
- 26 (G) IMMEDIATELY REMOVE THE PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER VALUABLE
- 27 THING FROM THE WEBSITE IF THE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY

- 1 DETERMINES THAT THE PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER VALUABLE THING IS
- 2 STOLEN.
