

SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR
HOUSE BILL NO. 6110

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled
"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"
(MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding section 74126.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 74126. (1) THE STATE OWNED LAND CONTAINING THE WHITE PINE
2 TRAIL, WHICH TRAVERSES AN ABANDONED RAIL CORRIDOR BETWEEN COMSTOCK
3 PARK AND CADILLAC, SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE "FRED MEIJER WHITE PINE
4 TRAIL STATE PARK".

5 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL FACILITATE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A
6 RECREATIONAL TRAIL THAT TRAVERSES, IN PART, THE ABANDONED RAIL
7 CORRIDOR THAT RUNS FROM WHITE LAKE DRIVE, SOUTH OF THE CITY OF
8 WHITEHALL, TO LAKE AVENUE IN THE CITY OF NORTH MUSKEGON. THIS TRAIL
9 SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE "FRED MEIJER BERRY JUNCTION TRAIL".

10 (3) THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE COMMITTEE, THE

1 COMMISSION, AND THE MICHIGAN NATURAL RESOURCES TRUST FUND BOARD
2 ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 1905, SHALL DEVELOP CRITERIA FOR NAMING
3 STATE PARKS AND OTHER STATE OWNED RECREATIONAL FACILITIES. WITHIN 1
4 YEAR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS
5 SUBSECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PRESENT TO THE STANDING COMMITTEES
6 OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES WITH JURISDICTION
7 PRIMARILY RELATING TO NATURAL RESOURCES AND STATE PARKS THE
8 CRITERIA IT HAS DEVELOPED UNDER THIS SECTION.
