## SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 6392

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 16184 (MCL 333.16184), as added by 2006 PA 24.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 16184. (1) An individual who is retired from the active
- 2 practice of medicine, osteopathic medicine and surgery, -or
- 3 podiatric medicine and surgery, OR DENTISTRY and who wishes to
- 4 donate his or her expertise for the medical OR DENTAL care and
- 5 treatment of indigent and needy individuals in this state or for
- 6 the medical OR DENTAL care and treatment of individuals in
- 7 medically underserved areas of this state may obtain a special
- 8 volunteer license to engage in the practice of medicine,
- 9 osteopathic medicine and surgery, -or podiatric medicine and

- 1 surgery, OR DENTISTRY by submitting an application to the board
- 2 pursuant to this section. An application for a special volunteer
- 3 license shall be on a form provided by the department and shall
- 4 include each of the following:
- 5 (a) Documentation that the individual has been previously
- 6 licensed to engage in the practice of medicine, osteopathic
- 7 medicine and surgery, or podiatric medicine and surgery, OR
- 8 DENTISTRY in this state and that his or her license was in good
- 9 standing prior to the expiration of his or her license.
- 10 (b) Acknowledgment and documentation that the applicant will
- 11 not receive any payment or compensation, either direct or indirect,
- 12 or have the expectation of any payment or compensation, for any
- 13 medical OR DENTAL care services provided under the special
- 14 volunteer license.
- 15 (c) If the applicant has been out of practice for 3 or more
- 16 years, documentation that, during the 3 years immediately preceding
- 17 the application, he or she has attended at least 2/3 of the
- 18 continuing education courses or programs required under part 170,
- 19 175, —or— 180, OR 166 for the renewal of a license.
- 20 (2) If the board determines that the application of the
- 21 individual satisfies the requirements of subsection (1) and that
- 22 the individual meets the requirements for a license as prescribed
- 23 by this article and rules promulgated under this article, the board
- 24 shall grant a special volunteer license to the applicant. A
- 25 licensee seeking renewal under this section shall provide the board
- 26 with an updated acknowledgment and documentation as described under
- 27 subsection (1)(b). Except as otherwise provided under this

- 1 subsection, the board shall not charge a fee for the issuance or
- 2 renewal of a special volunteer license under this section.
- 3 (3) Except as otherwise provided under this subsection, an
- 4 individual who is granted a special volunteer license pursuant to
- 5 this section and who accepts the privilege of practicing medicine,
- 6 osteopathic medicine and surgery, -or podiatric medicine and
- 7 surgery, OR DENTISTRY in this state is subject to all of the
- 8 provisions of this article, including those provisions concerning
- 9 continuing education and disciplinary action.
- 10 (4) For purposes of this section, an individual is considered
- 11 retired from practice if the individual's license has expired with
- 12 the individual's intention of ceasing to engage in the practice of
- 13 medicine, osteopathic medicine and surgery, -or podiatric medicine
- 14 and surgery, OR DENTISTRY for remuneration.
