3 offense variable 9 by determining which of the following apply

and by assigning the number of points attributable to the one

(a) Multiple deaths occurred

100 points

(b) There were 10 or more victims [WHO WERE PLACED IN DANGER OF PHYSICAL INJURY OR DEATH, OR 20 OR MORE VICTIMS WHO WERE PLACED IN DANGER OF PROPERTY LOSS]

- 2 (d) There were fewer than 2 victims 0 points
  [WHO WERE PLACED IN DANGER OF PHYSICAL
  INJURY OR DEATH, OR FEWER THAN 4 VICTIMS
  WHO WERE PLACED IN DANGER OF PROPERTY
  LOSS]

- 5 (a) Count each person who was placed in danger of PHYSICAL
- 6 injury or loss of life OR PROPERTY as a victim.
