SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 59

A bill to amend 1846 RS 83, entitled "Of marriage and the solemnization thereof," by amending section 7 (MCL 551.7), as amended by 2006 PA 419.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 7. (1) Marriages may be solemnized by any of the
- 2 following:
- 3 (a) A judge of the district court, in the district in which
- 4 the judge is serving.
- 5 (b) A district court magistrate, in the district in which the
- 6 magistrate serves.
- 7 (c) A municipal judge, in the city in which the judge is
- 8 serving or in a township over which a municipal court has
- 9 jurisdiction according to section 9928 of the revised judicature
- 10 act of 1961, 1961 PA 236, MCL 600.9928.
- 11 (d) A judge of probate, in the county or probate court

- 1 district in which the judge is serving.
- 2 (e) A judge of a federal court.
- 3 (f) A mayor of a city, ANYWHERE in the city A COUNTY in
- 4 which the mayor serves THAT CITY IS LOCATED.
- 5 (g) The county clerk in the county in which the clerk serves
- 6 or, in a county having more than 2,000,000 inhabitants, an employee
- 7 of the clerk's office designated by the county clerk in the county
- 8 in which the clerk serves.
- 9 (h) A minister of the gospel or cleric or religious
- 10 practitioner, anywhere in the state, if the minister or cleric or
- 11 religious practitioner is ordained or authorized to solemnize
- 12 marriages according to the usages of the denomination.
- 13 (i) A minister of the gospel or cleric or religious
- 14 practitioner, anywhere in the state, if the minister or cleric or
- 15 religious practitioner is not a resident of this state but is
- 16 authorized to solemnize marriages under the laws of the state in
- 17 which the minister or cleric or religious practitioner resides.
- 18 (2) A person authorized by this act to solemnize a marriage
- 19 shall keep proper records and make returns as required by section 4
- 20 of 1887 PA 128, MCL 551.104.
- 21 (3) If a mayor of a city solemnizes a marriage, the mayor
- 22 shall charge and collect a fee to be determined by the council of
- 23 that city, which shall be paid to the city treasurer and deposited
- 24 in the general fund of the city at the end of the month.
- 25 (4) If the county clerk or, in a county having more than
- 26 2,000,000 inhabitants, an employee of the clerk's office designated
- 27 by the county clerk solemnizes a marriage, the county clerk shall

- 1 charge and collect a fee to be determined by the commissioners of
- 2 that county, which shall be paid to the county treasurer and
- 3 deposited in the general fund of the county at the end of the
- 4 month.
