## HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 69

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

by amending section 1311g (MCL 380.1311g), as added by 1999 PA 23.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1311g. (1) A strict discipline academy may be located in
- 2 all or part of an existing public school building. Except for a
- 3 strict discipline academy that includes pupils who are the
- 4 responsibility of a county juvenile agency, a strict discipline
- 5 academy shall not operate at a site other than the single site
- 6 requested for the configuration of grades that will use the site,
- 7 as specified in the application required under section 1311d and in
- 8 the contract.
- 9 (2) A strict discipline academy shall not charge tuition.
- 10 Except as otherwise provided in subsection (5), a strict discipline
- 11 academy shall not discriminate in its pupil admissions policies or

- 1 practices on the basis of intellectual or athletic ability,
- 2 measures of achievement or aptitude, status as a handicapped
- 3 person, or any other basis that would be illegal if used by a
- 4 school district. However, a strict discipline academy may limit
- 5 admission to pupils who are within a particular range of age or
- 6 grade level or on any other basis that would be legal if used by a
- 7 school district.
- 8 (3) A strict discipline academy shall be established under
- **9** sections 1311b to 1311l specifically for enrolling 1 or more of the
- 10 following types of pupils:
- 11 (a) Pupils placed in the strict discipline academy by a court
- 12 or by the <u>family independence agency</u> **DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES**
- 13 or a county juvenile agency under the direction of a court.
- 14 (b) Pupils who have been expelled under section 1311(2).
- 15 (c) Pupils who have been expelled under section 1311a or
- 16 another provision of this act.
- 17 (d) Other [expelled pupils PUPILS WHO HAVE BEEN EXPELLED FROM SCHOOL, OR PUPILS WHO HAVE BEEN SUSPENDED FROM SCHOOL FOR A SUSPENSION THAT IS FOR A PERIOD IN EXCESS OF 10 SCHOOL DAYS, AND] WHO ARE
- 18 referred to the strict discipline academy by that pupil's school
- 19 and placed in the strict discipline academy by the pupil's parent
- 20 or legal quardian. HOWEVER, A SUSPENDED PUPIL SHALL BE ALLOWED TO
- 21 ATTEND THE STRICT DISCIPLINE ACADEMY ONLY FOR THE DURATION OF THE
- 22 SUSPENSION.
- 23 (4) In addition to the types of pupils specified in subsection
- 24 (3), a strict discipline public school academy shall be open for
- 25 enrollment of a special education pupil who does not meet the
- 26 requirements of subsection (3) if the special education pupil's
- 27 individualized <u>educational planning committee</u> EDUCATION PROGRAM

- 1 TEAM recommends that the special education pupil be placed in the
- 2 strict discipline public school academy. As used in this
- 3 subsection, "individualized -educational planning committee
- 4 EDUCATION PROGRAM TEAM" means that term as defined -in R 340.1701a
- 5 of the Michigan administrative code or an individualized education
- 6 program team as defined in section 614 of part B of title VI of
- 7 the individuals with disabilities education act, Public Law 91-230,
- 8 <del>20 U.S.C.</del> **20 USC** 1414.
- 9 (5) A strict discipline academy shall enroll only 1 or more of
- 10 the types of pupils described in subsection (3) or (4). A strict
- 11 discipline academy is not required to keep any group of pupils
- 12 described in subsection (3) or (4) physically separated from
- 13 another group of those pupils, as might otherwise be required under
- 14 section 1311, section 1311a, or another provision of this act.
- 15 (6) Strict discipline academies are not intended to enroll or
- 16 otherwise be used to educate individuals who are committed to a
- 17 high-security or medium-security juvenile facility operated by the
- 18 family independence agency DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES or another
- 19 state department or agency. Further, if the <u>family independence</u>
- 20 agency DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES, department of corrections, or
- 21 another state department or agency has custody of or jurisdiction
- 22 over a child, that state department or agency has the financial
- 23 responsibility for educating the child.
- 24 (7) Except for a foreign exchange student who is not a United
- 25 States citizen, a strict discipline academy shall not enroll a
- 26 pupil who is not a resident of this state. Enrollment in the strict
- 27 discipline academy may be open to all individuals who reside in

- 1 this state who meet the admission policy under subsections (3) and
- 2 (4) and shall be open to all pupils who reside within the
- 3 geographic boundaries, if any, of the authorizing body as described
- 4 in section 1311d who meet the admission policy under subsections
- 5 (3) and (4), except that admission to a strict discipline academy
- 6 authorized by the board of a community college to operate, or
- 7 operated by the board of a community college, on the grounds of a
- 8 federal military installation, as described in section 1311d, shall
- 9 be open to all pupils who reside in the county in which the federal
- 10 military installation is located who meet the admission policy
- 11 under subsections (3) and (4). For a strict discipline academy
- 12 authorized by a state public university, enrollment shall be open
- 13 to all pupils who reside in this state who meet the admission
- 14 policy under subsections (3) and (4). If there are more
- 15 applications to enroll in the strict discipline academy than there
- 16 are spaces available, pupils shall be selected to attend using a
- 17 random selection process. However, a strict discipline academy may
- 18 give enrollment priority to a sibling of a pupil enrolled in the
- 19 strict discipline academy. —A— EXCEPT FOR A SUSPENDED PUPIL WHO IS
- 20 ATTENDING THE STRICT DISCIPLINE ACADEMY FOR THE DURATION OF THE
- 21 SUSPENSION, A strict discipline academy shall allow any pupil who
- 22 was enrolled in the strict discipline academy in the immediately
- 23 preceding school year to enroll in the strict discipline academy in
- 24 the appropriate grade unless the appropriate grade is not offered
- 25 at that strict discipline academy.
- 26 (8) A strict discipline academy may include any grade up to
- 27 grade 12 or any configuration of those grades, including

- kindergarten and early childhood education, as specified in its 1
- contract. The authorizing body may approve amendment of a contract 2
- with respect to ages of pupils or grades offered. 3
