January 25, 2005, Introduced by Senators CASSIS, ALLEN, SWITALSKI, GARCIA and GOSCHKA and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1964 PA 287, entitled

"An act to provide for the organization and functions of the state boards of education under the constitutions of 1908 and 1963; to provide for the appointment and functions of the superintendent of public instruction under the constitution of 1963; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

by amending section 9a (MCL 388.1009a), as amended by 1983 PA 240.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 9a. The special education advisory committee is created

in the department of education and shall consist of not less than 9
and not more than -27-33 members -, who shall be appointed, in

multiples of 3, APPOINTED by the state board of education for

terms of 3 years. -, except that of the members first appointed in

1983 or thereafter, 1/3 shall be appointed for a term of 3 years,

1/3 for a term of 2 years, and 1/3 for a term of 1 year. The
