## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 10. (1) Except as provided in this act, a registration or
- 2 report is confidential and information from that registration or
- 3 report shall not be open to inspection except for law enforcement
- 4 purposes. The registration or report and all included materials and
- 5 information are exempt from disclosure under section 13 of the
- 6 freedom of information act, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.243.
- 7 (2) A department post, local law enforcement agency, or
- 8 sheriff's department shall make information from the compilation
- 9 described in section 8(2) for the zip code areas located in whole

- 21 than 93 days or a fine of not more than \$1,000.00, or both.
