THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 629d. (1) The legislature shall establish a highway safety task force to study the effects of the amendatory act that added this section and enforcement efforts that may be required as a result of its implementation. Five members of the task force shall be appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives and 5 members shall be appointed by the senate majority leader. The director of the department of state police, the director of the department of transportation, and the secretary of state shall
