

HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR
SENATE BILL NO. 934

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled
"Michigan vehicle code,"
(MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding section 307b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 307B. (1) BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2010, WHEN ANY MALE
2 CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES OR A MALE IMMIGRANT TO THE UNITED
3 STATES WHO IS LESS THAN 26 YEARS OF AGE APPLIES FOR AN OPERATOR'S
4 LICENSE OR CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE, THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL, WITH
5 THE APPLICANT'S CONSENT, OBTAIN THE INFORMATION THAT IS NECESSARY
6 TO REGISTER THE APPLICANT WITH THE FEDERAL SELECTIVE SERVICE SYSTEM
7 IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF 50 USC APPX 453, INCLUDING,
8 BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE APPLICANT'S SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER.
- 9 (2) EACH APPLICATION DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) SHALL
10 CONTAIN ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

1 (A) A STATEMENT THAT, IF THE APPLICANT GIVES HIS CONSENT TO
2 THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO PROVIDE HIS REGISTRATION INFORMATION TO
3 THE SELECTIVE SERVICE SYSTEM, THE SECRETARY OF STATE IS AUTHORIZED
4 TO PROVIDE THAT INFORMATION TO THE SELECTIVE SERVICE SYSTEM UNDER
5 THIS SECTION.

6 (B) THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT: "IF I AM LESS THAN 18 YEARS OF
7 AGE AND GIVE MY CONSENT TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO PROVIDE THE
8 INFORMATION NECESSARY TO REGISTER ME FOR SELECTIVE SERVICE, I
9 UNDERSTAND THAT I WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE REGISTERED FOR SELECTIVE
10 SERVICE WHEN I BECOME 18 YEARS OF AGE IF REQUIRED BY FEDERAL LAW.".

11 (C) A STATEMENT OF THE CRIMINAL PENALTIES AND OTHER SANCTIONS
12 THAT APPLY FOR FAILING TO REGISTER WITH SELECTIVE SERVICE.

13 (D) THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT: "I ACKNOWLEDGE HAVING BEEN GIVEN
14 INFORMATION REGARDING THE PENALTIES FOR NOT REGISTERING FOR
15 SELECTIVE SERVICE.".

16 (E) A STATEMENT APPEARING IN CAPITALIZED, BOLD-FACED TYPE THAT
17 DECLINING TO GIVE CONSENT TO REGISTRATION UNDER THIS SECTION DOES
18 NOT AFFECT THE APPLICANT'S PRIVILEGE TO RECEIVE AN OPERATOR'S OR
19 CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE.

20 (F) A LOCATION ON THE APPLICATION WHERE THE APPLICANT SHALL
21 INDICATE THAT HE EITHER CONSENTS TO FORWARDING HIS REGISTRATION
22 INFORMATION TO THE SELECTIVE SERVICE SYSTEM OR THAT HE DOES NOT
23 CONSENT TO FORWARDING HIS REGISTRATION INFORMATION TO THE SELECTIVE
24 SERVICE SYSTEM.

25 (3) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL FORWARD THE INFORMATION
26 OBTAINED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) TO THE FEDERAL SELECTIVE SERVICE
27 SYSTEM IN A FORMAT CONSISTENT WITH SELECTIVE SERVICE SYSTEM

1 REQUIREMENTS.

2 (4) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL NOT FORWARD ANY INFORMATION
3 REGARDING AN APPLICANT WHO IS LESS THAN 18 YEARS OF AGE TO THE
4 SELECTIVE SERVICE SYSTEM UNDER THIS SECTION UNLESS THE APPLICANT
5 GIVES HIS CONSENT TO PROVIDE THAT INFORMATION TO THE SELECTIVE
6 SERVICE SYSTEM AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.

7 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect October
8 1, 2010.
