(MCL 484.2101 to 484.2701) by adding section 360a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 360A. <<(1)>> A PROVIDER OF CELLULAR OR MOBILE TELECOMMUNICATION
- 2 SERVICE SHALL NOT PROVIDE, SELL, OR INCLUDE THE DIALING NUMBER OF A
- 3 CUSTOMER FOR INCLUSION WITH ANY DIRECTORY ASSISTANCE WITHOUT FIRST
- OBTAINING THE WRITTEN <OR ELECTRONIC >> CONSENT OF THE CUSTOMER. <<A CUSTOMER MAY REVOKE SUCH CONSENT AT ANY TIME. A PROVIDER OF CELLULAR OR MOBILE TELECOMMUNICATION SERVICE SHALL REMOVE THE LISTING OF SUCH A CUSTOMER FROM DIRECTORY ASSISTANCE AND NOT INCLUDE IT IN FUTURE PUBLICATIONS OR COMMUNICATIONS OF THE DIRECTORY. A CELLULAR OR MOBILE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE CUSTOMER SHALL NOT BE CHARGED FOR MAKING THE CHOICE TO NOT BE INCLUDED WITH ANY DIRECTORY ASSISTANCE.
 - (2) THE WRITTEN CONSENT REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) SHALL BE ON A SEPARATE DOCUMENT PROVIDED FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF OBTAINING THE CUSTOMER'S CONSENT.>>
