## SENATE BILL NO. 308

## A bill to amend 1978 PA 33, entitled

"An act to prohibit the dissemination, exhibiting, or displaying of certain sexually explicit matter to minors; to prohibit certain misrepresentations facilitating the dissemination of sexually explicit matter to minors; to provide penalties; to provide for declaratory judgments and injunctive relief in certain instances; to impose certain duties upon prosecuting attorneys and the circuit court; to preempt local units of government from proscribing certain conduct; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

by amending section 6 (MCL 722.676), as amended by 2003 PA 192.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 6. Section 5 does not apply to the dissemination of
- 2 sexually explicit matter to a minor by any of the following:
- 3 (a) A parent or guardian who disseminates sexually explicit
- 4 matter to his or her child or ward UNLESS THE DISSEMINATION IS FOR
- 5 THE SEXUAL GRATIFICATION OF THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN.
- 6 (b) A teacher or administrator at a public or private

- 1 elementary or secondary school that complies with the revised
- 2 school code, 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.1 to 380.1852, and who
- 3 disseminates sexually explicit matter to a student as part of a
- 4 school program permitted by law.
- 5 (c) A licensed physician or licensed psychologist who
- 6 disseminates sexually explicit matter in the treatment of a
- 7 patient.
- 8 (d) A librarian employed by a library of a public or private
- 9 elementary or secondary school that complies with the revised
- 10 school code, 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.1 to 380.1852, or employed by a
- 11 public library, who disseminates sexually explicit matter in the
- 12 course of that person's employment.
- (e) Any public or private college or university or any other
- 14 person who disseminates sexually explicit matter for a legitimate
- 15 medical, scientific, governmental, or judicial purpose.
- 16 (f) A person who disseminates sexually explicit matter that is
- 17 a public document, publication, record, or other material issued by
- 18 a state, local, or federal official, department, board, commission,
- 19 agency, or other governmental entity, or an accurate republication
- 20 of such a public document, publication, record, or other material.
- 21 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect February
