

SUBSTITUTE FOR
SENATE BILL NO. 567

A bill to amend 1972 PA 106, entitled
"Highway advertising act of 1972,"
(MCL 252.301 to 252.325) by adding section 7a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 7A. FROM THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT
2 ADDED THIS SECTION UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2008, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
3 NOT ISSUE A PERMIT FOR A SIGN UNLESS THE APPLICANT SURRENDERS A
4 PREVIOUSLY ISSUED PERMIT. A PERMIT ISSUED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION
5 SHALL COMPLY WITH THIS ACT. EXCEPT FOR ANY SIGN REMOVED IN
6 ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 19, IF A SIGN FOR WHICH A PERMIT HAS BEEN
7 ISSUED IS REMOVED FOR ANY REASON, THE PERMIT HOLDER MAY NOTIFY THE
8 DEPARTMENT OF THE SIGN'S REMOVAL AND EXCHANGE THE PERMIT FOR THE
9 REMOVED SIGN FOR AN INTERIM PERMIT WITH NO DESIGNATED SIGN

1 LOCATION. IF A SIGN HAS BEEN REMOVED FROM AN AREA THAT IS
2 NONCONFORMING UNDER APPLICABLE ZONING DESIGNATIONS, ANY SIGN ISSUED
3 UNDER AN INTERIM PERMIT SHALL NOT BE IN A NONCONFORMING AREA UNDER
4 APPLICABLE ZONING DESIGNATIONS. AN INTERIM PERMIT SHALL BE
5 SURRENDERED WITH AN APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT FOR A SIGN.

6 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
7 unless Senate Bill No. 568

8 of the 93rd Legislature is enacted into law.
