## SENATE BILL NO. 727

- 2 (a) "Center" or "defense contract coordination center" means

- 4 Sec. 2. (1) The defense contract coordination center is
- 5 created in the Michigan economic development corporation. The
- 6 center shall report directly to the president of the Michigan
- 7 economic development corporation.
- 8 (2) The center shall do all of the following:
- 9 (a) Focus solely on job creation and job retention from
- 10 business opportunities associated <<with the procurement technical</pre>
- assistance center (PTAC) or with defense, homeland security, and other
  qovernment contracts.>>
- 12 (b) Coordinate with procurement technical assistance centers
- 13 in this state to maximize business opportunities for businesses
