## SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 895

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled
"The revised school code,"
by amending section 632 (MCL 380.632) and by adding sections 506a,
527a, 633, 1255, and 1311m.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 506A. IF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL
- 2 ACADEMY PROVIDES MEDICAL, OPTICAL, OR DENTAL BENEFITS TO EMPLOYEES
- 3 AND THEIR DEPENDENTS, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS SHALL PROVIDE THOSE
- 4 BENEFITS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SCHOOL EMPLOYEES HEALTH BENEFIT ACT
- 5 AND SHALL COMPLY WITH THAT ACT.
- 6 SEC. 527A. IF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF AN URBAN HIGH SCHOOL
- 7 ACADEMY PROVIDES MEDICAL, OPTICAL, OR DENTAL BENEFITS TO EMPLOYEES
- 8 AND THEIR DEPENDENTS, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS SHALL PROVIDE THOSE
- 9 BENEFITS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SCHOOL EMPLOYEES HEALTH BENEFIT ACT

- 1 AND SHALL COMPLY WITH THAT ACT.
- 2 Sec. 632. (1) In the process of establishing salaries or
- 3 determining other working conditions, the intermediate school board
- 4 may provide other related benefits of an economic nature on a joint
- 5 participating or nonparticipating basis with intermediate school
- 6 district employees. —The— SUBJECT TO SECTION 633, THE benefits may
- 7 include health and accident insurance coverage, group life
- 8 insurance, annuity contracts, and reimbursement for credit hours
- 9 earned during employment for professional improvement.
- 10 (2) After a teacher has been employed at least 7 consecutive
- 11 years by the intermediate school board, and at the end of each
- 12 additional period of 7 or more consecutive years of employment, the
- 13 intermediate school board may grant the teacher a sabbatical leave
- 14 for professional improvement for not to exceed 2 semesters at 1
- 15 time, if the teacher holds a permanent, life, or continuing
- 16 certificate. During the sabbatical leave, the teacher shall be
- 17 considered to be in the employ of the intermediate school board,
- 18 shall have a contract, and may be paid compensation under the
- 19 regulations of the intermediate school board. The intermediate
- 20 school board shall not be held liable for death or injuries
- 21 sustained by a teacher while on sabbatical leave.
- 22 SEC. 633. IF THE INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL BOARD OF AN INTERMEDIATE
- 23 SCHOOL DISTRICT PROVIDES MEDICAL, OPTICAL, OR DENTAL BENEFITS TO
- 24 EMPLOYEES AND THEIR DEPENDENTS, THE INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL BOARD SHALL
- 25 PROVIDE THOSE BENEFITS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SCHOOL EMPLOYEES
- 26 HEALTH BENEFIT ACT AND SHALL COMPLY WITH THAT ACT.
- 27 SEC. 1255. IF THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT PROVIDES MEDICAL,

- 1 OPTICAL, OR DENTAL BENEFITS TO EMPLOYEES AND THEIR DEPENDENTS, THE
- 2 BOARD SHALL PROVIDE THOSE BENEFITS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SCHOOL
- 3 EMPLOYEES HEALTH BENEFIT ACT AND SHALL COMPLY WITH THAT ACT.
- 4 SEC. 1311M. IF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF A STRICT DISCIPLINE
- 5 ACADEMY PROVIDES MEDICAL, OPTICAL, OR DENTAL BENEFITS TO EMPLOYEES
- 6 AND THEIR DEPENDENTS, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS SHALL PROVIDE THOSE
- 7 BENEFITS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SCHOOL EMPLOYEES HEALTH BENEFIT ACT
- 8 AND SHALL COMPLY WITH THAT ACT.
- 9 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 10 unless all of the following bills of the 93rd Legislature are
- 11 enacted into law:
