

# SENATE BILL No. 1141

March 14, 2006, Introduced by Senators TOY, GARCIA, BIRKHOLZ, STAMAS, VAN WOERKOM, HARDIMAN, BISHOP, KUIPERS, GOSCHKA, JELINEK, CROPSEY and SCHAUER and referred to the Committee on Economic Development, Small Business and Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1944 (1st Ex Sess) PA 52, entitled

"An act to provide for the establishment of and quieting the title to and the recreating of the public records of lands in counties where records of title have been destroyed in whole or in any material part by fire, flood or other major disaster, and to establish the procedure therefor and to provide an appropriation to pay certain costs thereof,"

by amending section 16 (MCL 561.16).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 16. ~~There is hereby appropriated from the general fund~~  
2 ~~from moneys not otherwise appropriated for the fiscal year ending~~  
3 ~~June 30, 1945 the sum of \$10,000.00 which shall be paid out of the~~
