## SUBSTITUTE FOR

## SENATE BILL NO. 1257

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 716 (MCL 257.716), as amended by 1998 PA 427.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 716. (1) Unless specifically declared to be a civil
- 2 infraction, it is a misdemeanor for a person to drive or move or
- 3 for the owner to cause or permit to be driven or moved on a highway
- 4 a vehicle or vehicles of a size or weight exceeding the limitations
- 5 stated in this chapter or otherwise in violation of this chapter,
- 6 and the maximum size and weight specified in this chapter -shall be
- 7 ARE lawful throughout this state, and local authorities shall not
- 8 alter those size and weight limitations except as express authority
- 9 is granted in this chapter.

- 1 (2) The provisions of this chapter governing size, weight, and
- 2 load shall DO not apply to a fire apparatus, to an implement of
- 3 husbandry incidentally moved upon a highway, a combination of
- 4 vehicles described in, and under the conditions provided by,
- 5 subsection (4), or to a vehicle operated under the terms of a
- 6 special permit issued as provided in this chapter.
- 7 (3) The state transportation department, -pursuant to UNDER
- 8 the administrative procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201
- 9 to 24.328, may promulgate rules permitting and regulating the
- 10 operation of a vehicle or vehicles of a size or weight which THAT
- 11 exceeds the size or weight limitations in this chapter. The rules
- 12 may restrict or proscribe the conditions of operation of a vehicle
- 13 or vehicles of a size or weight <u>which</u> THAT exceeds the size or
- 14 weight limitations in this chapter, if the restriction or
- 15 proscription is necessary to protect the public safety or to
- 16 prevent undue damage to a road foundation or surface, a structure,
- 17 or an installation. The rules may provide for a reasonable
- 18 inspection fee for an inspection of a vehicle or vehicles to
- 19 determine whether their sizes and weights are in conformance with
- 20 this act, and may require other security necessary to compensate
- 21 for damage caused by the vehicle or vehicles described in this
- 22 subsection.
- 23 (4) A wrecker and a disabled vehicle, or a wrecker and a
- 24 combination of a disabled vehicle and 1 trailer, that exceeds the
- 25 size and weight limitations in this chapter may be operated upon
- 26 the highways of this state under the following conditions:
- 27 (a) The wrecker is specifically designed for such towing

- 1 operations, is equipped with flashing, oscillating, or rotating
- 2 amber or red lights as permitted under section 698, and is capable
- 3 of utilizing the lighting and braking systems of the disabled
- 4 vehicle or combination of disabled vehicles if those systems are
- 5 operational.
- 6 (b) The FOR A COMBINATION OF DISABLED VEHICLES, THE wrecker
- 7 is issued <del>an extended restricted</del> A SPECIAL permit under section
- 8 725 by the state transportation department if each trip beginning
- 9 from the place of original disablement of the <del>disabled vehicle or</del>
- 10 combination of DISABLED vehicles is 25 miles or less except that,
- 11 for each trip that begins and ends north of a line between
- 12 Ludington and Pinconning, the trip beginning from the place of
- 13 original disablement of the <u>disabled vehicle or</u> combination of
- 14 vehicles may be 50 miles or less. THE SPECIAL PERMIT IS VALID FOR
- 15 THE ENTIRE TOWING DISTANCE SET FORTH IN THIS SUBDIVISION, AND THE
- 16 OPERATOR OF THE WRECKER MAY REMOVE THE DISABLED VEHICLES FROM THE
- 17 ROADWAY AT ANY LAWFUL POINT OF HIS OR HER CHOOSING WITHIN THAT
- 18 DISTANCE.
- 19 (C) FOR A SINGLE DISABLED VEHICLE, THE WRECKER IS ISSUED A
- 20 SPECIAL PERMIT UNDER SECTION 725 BY THE STATE TRANSPORTATION
- 21 DEPARTMENT FOR THE TRANSPORT OF THE DISABLED VEHICLE. A WRECKER
- 22 OPERATOR IS NOT SUBJECT TO MILEAGE LIMITATIONS FOR A SPECIAL PERMIT
- 23 ISSUED FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SUBDIVISION.
- 24 (D) -(c) The wrecker does not operate on any highway, road,
- 25 street, or structure included on a list provided by the state
- 26 transportation department unless the disabled vehicle or
- 27 combination of vehicles is located on 1 of those roads or

- structures. 1
- 2 (5) The owner or operator of a wrecker that does not comply
- with subsection -(4)(c) (4)(D) is responsible for a civil 3
- infraction and shall pay a civil fine of not less than \$250.00 -but 4
- $\frac{1}{1000}$  or more than \$500.00. The civil fine imposed  $\frac{1}{1000}$  UNDER this 5
- subsection is in addition to any fine that may be imposed under 6
- 7 section 724 or 725.
