## SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 1148

A bill to amend 1996 PA 376, entitled "Michigan renaissance zone act,"

by amending section 8a (MCL 125.2688a), as amended by 2006 PA 440.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 8a. (1) Except as provided in subsections (2), (3), and
- 2 (4), the board shall not designate more than 9 additional
- 3 renaissance zones within this state under this section. Not more
- 4 than 6 of the renaissance zones shall be located in urban areas and
- 5 not more than 5 of the renaissance zones shall be located in rural
- 6 areas. For purposes of determining whether a renaissance zone is
- 7 located in an urban area or rural area under this section, if any
- 8 part of a renaissance zone is located within an urban area, the
- 9 entire renaissance zone shall be considered to be located in an

- 1 urban area.
- 2 (2) The board of the Michigan strategic fund described in
- 3 section 4 of the Michigan strategic fund act, 1984 PA 270, MCL
- 4 125.2004, may designate not more than -10 13 additional
- 5 renaissance zones within this state in 1 or more cities, villages,
- 6 or townships if that city, village, or township or combination of
- 7 cities, villages, or townships consents to the creation of a
- 8 renaissance zone within their boundaries. The board of the Michigan
- 9 strategic fund may designate not more than 1 of the  $\frac{10}{10}$  13
- 10 additional renaissance zones described in this subsection as an
- 11 alternative energy zone. An alternative energy zone shall promote
- 12 and increase the research, development, and manufacturing of
- 13 alternative energy technology as that term is defined in the
- 14 Michigan next energy authority act. An alternative energy zone
- 15 shall have a duration of renaissance zone status for a period not
- 16 to exceed 20 years as determined by the board of the Michigan
- 17 strategic fund. Not later than April 16, 2004, the board of the
- 18 Michigan strategic fund may designate not more than 1 of the -10
- 19 13 additional renaissance zones described in this subsection as a
- 20 pharmaceutical renaissance zone. A pharmaceutical renaissance zone
- 21 shall promote and increase the research, development, and
- 22 manufacturing of pharmaceutical products of an eligible
- 23 pharmaceutical company. The board of the Michigan strategic fund
- 24 may designate not more than -5 8 of the additional -10 13
- 25 renaissance zones described in this subsection as a redevelopment
- 26 renaissance zone. A redevelopment renaissance zone shall promote
- 27 the redevelopment of existing industrial facilities OR THE

- 1 DEVELOPMENT OF INDUSTRIAL PROPERTY. Before designating a
- 2 renaissance zone under this subsection, the board of the Michigan
- 3 strategic fund may enter into a development agreement with the
- 4 city, township, or village in which the renaissance zone will be
- 5 located AND THE OWNER OF THE FACILITY OR PROPERTY LOCATED IN THE
- 6 RENAISSANCE ZONE. THE DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT FOR A REDEVELOPMENT
- 7 RENAISSANCE ZONE DESCRIBED ONLY IN SUBSECTION (6) (B) (vi) OR (vii) MAY
- 8 PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF 1 OR MORE OF THE TAXES DESCRIBED IN
- 9 SECTION 9.
- 10 (3) In addition to the not more than 9 additional renaissance
- 11 zones described in subsection (1), the board may designate
- 12 additional renaissance zones within this state in 1 or more
- 13 qualified local governmental units if that qualified local
- 14 governmental unit or units contain a military installation that was
- 15 operated by the United States department of defense and was closed
- 16 in 1977 or after 1990.
- 17 (4) Land owned by a county or the qualified local governmental
- 18 unit or units adjacent to a zone as described in subsection (3) may
- 19 be included in this zone.
- 20 (5) Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, property
- 21 located in the alternative energy zone that is classified as
- 22 commercial real property under section 34c of the general property
- 23 tax act, 1893 PA 206, MCL 211.34c, and that the authority, with the
- 24 concurrence of the assessor of the local tax collecting unit,
- 25 determines is not used to directly promote and increase the
- 26 research, development, and manufacturing of alternative energy
- 27 technology is not eligible for any exemption, deduction, or credit

- 1 under section 9.
- 2 (6) As used in this section:
- 3 (a) "Eligible pharmaceutical company" means a company that
- 4 meets all of the following criteria:
- 5 (i) Is engaged primarily in manufacturing, research and
- 6 development, and sale of pharmaceuticals.
- 7 (ii) Has not less than 8,499 employees located in this state,
- 8 all of whom are located within a 100-mile radius of each other.
- 9 (iii) Of the total number of employees located in this state,
- 10 has not less than 4,800 engaged primarily in research and
- 11 development of pharmaceuticals.
- 12 (b) "Redevelopment renaissance zone" means a renaissance zone
- 13 that meets 1 of the following:
- 14 (i) All of the following:
- 15 (A) Is located in a city with a population of more than 7,500
- 16 and less than 8,500 and is located in a county with a population of
- 17 more than 60,000 and less than 70,000.
- 18 (B) Contains ONLY ALL OR A PORTION OF an industrial site of
- 19 200 or more acres.
- 20 (ii) All of the following:
- 21 (A) Is located in a city with a population of more than 13,000
- 22 and less than 14,000 and is located in a county with a population
- 23 of more than 1,000,000 and less than 1,300,000.
- 24 (B) Contains ONLY ALL OR A PORTION OF an industrial site of
- 25 300 or more contiquous acres.
- 26 (iii) All of the following:
- 27 (A) Is located in a township with a population of more than

- 1 5,500 and is located in a county with a population of less than
- 2 24,000.
- 3 (B) Contains ONLY ALL OR A PORTION OF an industrial site of
- 4 more than 850 acres and has railroad access.
- 5 (iv) All of the following:
- **6** (A) Is located in a city with a population of more than 40,000
- 7 and less than 44,000 and is located in a county with a population
- 8 of more than 81,000 and less than 87,000.
- 9 (B) Contains ONLY ALL OR A PORTION OF an industrial site of
- 10 more than 475 acres.
- 11 (v) All of the following:
- 12 (A) Is located in a city with a population of more than 21,000
- 13 and less than 26,000 and is located in a county with a population
- 14 of more than 573,000 and less than 625,000.
- 15 (B) Contains ONLY ALL OR A PORTION OF an industrial site of
- 16 less than 45 acres in size.
- 17 (vi) ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 18 (A) IS LOCATED IN A CITY WITH A POPULATION OF MORE THAN
- 19 190,000 AND LESS THAN 250,000 AND IS LOCATED IN A COUNTY WITH A
- 20 POPULATION OF MORE THAN 573,000 AND LESS THAN 625,000.
- 21 (B) CONTAINS ONLY ALL OR A PORTION OF AN INDUSTRIAL SITE OF
- 22 MORE THAN 14 ACRES AND LESS THAN 16 ACRES IN SIZE.
- 23 (C) IS APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF THE MICHIGAN STRATEGIC FUND ON
- 24 OR BEFORE APRIL 1, 2007.
- 25 (vii) ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 26 (A) IS LOCATED IN A CITY WITH A POPULATION OF MORE THAN 35,500
- 27 AND LESS THAN 36,800 AND IS LOCATED IN A COUNTY WITH A POPULATION

- 1 OF MORE THAN 157,000 AND LESS THAN 162,000.
- 2 (B) CONTAINS ONLY ALL OR A PORTION OF AN INDUSTRIAL SITE
- 3 COMPRISED OF 1 OR MORE ADJACENT PARCELS TOTALING 5 OR MORE ACRES.
- (C) IS APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF THE MICHIGAN STRATEGIC FUND ON 4
- OR BEFORE APRIL 1, 2007. 5
- 6 (viii) ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 7 (A) IS LOCATED IN A CITY WITH A POPULATION OF MORE THAN 40,000
- AND LESS THAN 44,000 AND IS LOCATED IN A COUNTY WITH A POPULATION 8
- 9 OF MORE THAN 81,000 AND LESS THAN 87,000.
- 10 (B) CONTAINS ONLY ALL OR A PORTION OF AN INDUSTRIAL SITE
- 11 COMPOSED OF 1 OR MORE ADJACENT PARCELS TOTALING 100 OR MORE ACRES.
- 12 (C) IS APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF THE MICHIGAN STRATEGIC FUND ON
- 13 OR BEFORE APRIL 1, 2008.
