SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 1169

A bill to amend 2000 PA 322, entitled "Julian-Stille value-added act,"

(MCL 285.301 to 285.304) by adding section 2a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 2A. (1) THE AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT FUND IS CREATED AS A
- 2 REVOLVING FUND WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY TO BE ADMINISTERED
- 3 BY THE DEPARTMENT. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT
- 4 OF THE FUND. MONEY IN THE FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR
- 5 SHALL REMAIN IN THE FUND AND SHALL NOT LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND.
- 6 THE DEPARTMENT MAY UTILIZE UP TO 4% OF THE FUND FOR ADMINISTRATIVE
- 7 PURPOSES. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT TO THE FUND MONEY FROM
- 8 THE FOLLOWING SOURCES:
- 9 (A) APPROPRIATIONS.

- 1 (B) MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS FROM ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE
- 2 FUND, INCLUDING FEDERAL MONEY, OTHER STATE REVENUES, GIFTS,
- 3 BEQUESTS, OR DONATIONS, AS WELL AS MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE
- 4 PROVIDED BY LAW.
- 5 (C) ANY MONEY REPRESENTING LOAN REPAYMENTS AND INTEREST ON THE
- 6 LOANS.
- 7 (2) OF THE MONEY APPROPRIATED DURING FISCAL YEAR 2005-2006
- 8 FROM THE 21ST CENTURY JOBS TRUST FUND, NOT MORE THAN 50% SHALL BE
- 9 USED FOR GRANTS AND THE REMAINING SHALL BE USED FOR LOANS AND LOAN
- 10 GUARANTEES. NOT LESS THAN 50% OF THE FUND SHALL BE AWARDED AS
- 11 GRANTS OR USED FOR LOANS AND LOAN GUARANTEES FOR SPECIALTY CROPS OR
- 12 PRODUCTS DERIVED FROM SPECIALTY CROPS. THE MAXIMUM GRANT FROM THE
- 13 FUND SHALL NOT EXCEED \$250,000.00. THE MAXIMUM LOAN OR LOAN
- 14 GUARANTEE SUPPORTED BY THE FUND SHALL NOT EXCEED \$500,000.00.
- 15 (3) UPON REQUEST FROM THE COMMISSION OF AGRICULTURE, THE STATE
- 16 TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY IN THE AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT
- 17 FUND IN A MANNER SIMILAR TO THE QUALIFIED AGRICULTURAL LOAN PROGRAM
- 18 ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 2A OF 1855 PA 105, MCL 21.142A, AS PROVIDED
- 19 IN SECTION 2.
- 20 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 21 unless all of the following bills of the 93rd Legislature are
- 22 enacted into law:
